## From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

I pray that your Lenten season has been blessed and penitential. Penance leads us to open our hearts to more of the mercy of God in our lives. Make it to confession this Lent if you have not already done so. We hear confessions each and every day (see the bulletin for the schedule) and will have a special communal celebration with individual confessions on Sunday, March 24th from 3:30 -5: 30 p.m. at St. Joe's. There will be about five priests here to help.

In the Gospel this weekend, March 3rd, Jesus spoke of his body as a temple. Destroy this temple and in three days I will raise it up again. Jesus' words were a mystery to those who heard him and they took offense at him. It was only understood when Jesus was laid in the tomb and raised by the Father after three days. This prophecy helped the disciples to more deeply believe and appreciate the scriptures and Jesus' words.

In the Gospel next weekend, March 10th, we hear the famous and perhaps most well known verse of scripture, John 3:15, "For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but have eternal life." Do we believe the Father will raise us up, too, with Jesus? Our entire faith is based on that faith and hope in eternal life for those who believe and follow the Son of God. Lord, grant us the gift of firm faith, constant hope, and unfailing charity!
