Fr. Chavez will be visiting our parish next weekend to speak at all the Masses on behalf of Cross Catholic Outreach, which was founded to forge a stronger and more supportive link between parishes in America and the priests and nuns serving the poor in the Caribbean, Africa, Southeast Asia, and Central and South America.

Father Carlos Chavez, a native New Mexican born in Socorro, was ordained at St. Francis Cathedral, Santa Fe, in 1984. He served as the pastor of Sacred Heart in Clovis, NM, for 23 years and as a parochial vicar in various parishes and ministries within the Archdiocese of Santa Fe during his 30 years of ordained ministry. Inspired by his grandmother's teachings to care for the poor, he felt called to the priesthood at 17. These lessons shaped his understanding of priesthood as a life of service, sacrifice, and joy in proclaiming Christ's truth. He emphasizes that Christians must embody the Eucharist in their lives, as St. Augustine taught. Fr. Chavez states, "The mission of Cross Catholic Outreach is at the heart of who I am as a Catholic priest."



My name is Diane Muller and I have had the privilege of being an adorer for the past several years. It was not that I eagerly signed up on my own. Colleen asked me if I would do an hour of adoration and to also expose the Eucharist. I was VERY reluctant to do it because I had no idea what I was expected to do in that hour. I learned there was nothing expected at all. You choose how you want to spend time with Jesus.

I usually begin my adoration time by putting in my earbuds and saying the rosary followed by listening to the beautiful Chaplet of Divine Mercy in song. Some of the other things I like to do during adoration is go into the "Formed" app, which is a wonderful resource that I use to learn about Saints and grow in my faith. I also watch "The Chosen" series. Sometimes I read during my adoration time as well.

If something is weighing heavy on my heart, I will just sit there and have a conversation with Jesus. It is easy, he is right there with me! At times it might feel like it's a one-sided conversation but then all the sudden I have had the experience where I look up at him up on the cross reminding me that he endured so much because he loves me that much and then I realize everything will be OK.

It did not take me very long after I started being an adorer that I really looked forward to it. I look at it as "My date with Jesus."

I think sometimes we tend to overthink what adoration is. I look at it as I know Jesus is always there for me, this time allows me some silent time to tell him Thank You! It truly brings me closer to him.




