

From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

Have you ever wanted more faith? I have. The disciples have. Faith is belief in that which is unseen. Or as the Letter to the Hebrews puts it, "Faith is the certainty of things hoped for, a proof of things not yet seen." It is belief that God is real and we can trust God is big enough to meet our needs. The disciples in this Sunday's Gospel ask Jesus to increase their faith. They recognize their lack of it. But Jesus refocuses their request onto the quality, not so much the quantity, of faith. Jesus told the disciples, "If you have faith the size of a mustard seed, you would say to this mulberry tree, 'Be uprooted and planted in the sea,' and it would obey you. A little faith goes a long way when it is directed toward God. When we place ourselves at the center, rather than God, our faith will falter. St. Carlo Acutis used to say, "Sadness is looking at ourselves; happiness is looking at God." When we look to God we find that we can "do all things in Him who strengthens me" as St. Paul says. Jesus says, "Most assuredly I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do because I go to my Father." Let us pray God increases our faith in Him, and in doing so, increases our capacity for happiness. Jesus, I trust in you....increase my faith.
