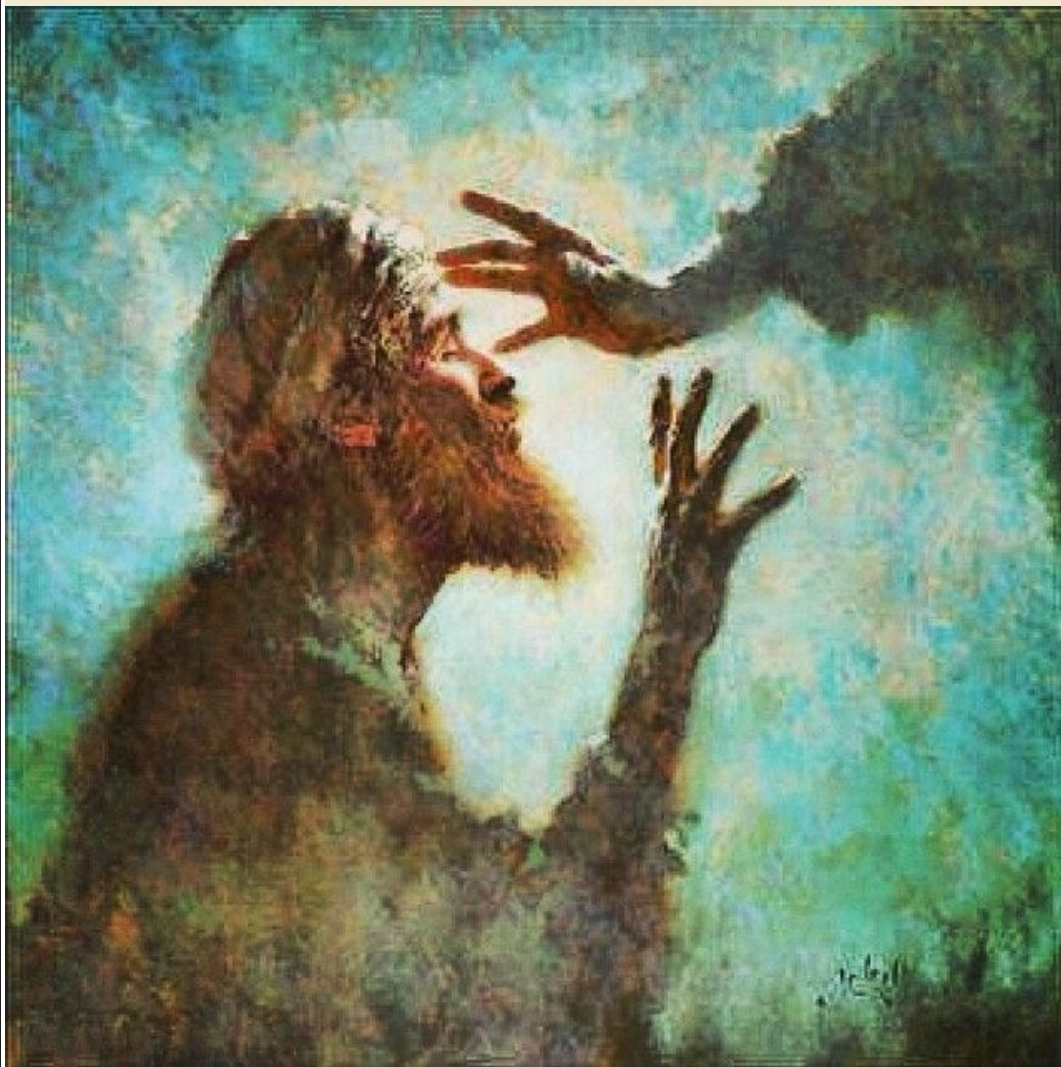

Dear Parishioners,

Reminder: The Sacrament of Reconciliation/i.e. Confession is available every day before Mass, and on Sunday March 30th from 3:30-5:30 p.m we have a handful of priests available for a Penance service at St. Joe's. We will begin with a short prayer service and then individual confessions. Come anytime between those two hours. The Lord is waiting for you to show you his great mercy for you!

In the gospel passage this weekend Jesus heals the man born blind. Jesus says, "Night is coming when no one can work. While I am in the world, I am the light of the world." Then he spat on the ground and made clay with saliva and smeared the clay on the man's eyes and sent him to wash in the pool of Siloam. The man OBEYED and went and washed, and came back able to see. When we obey Jesus, we will regain our spiritual sight. Obedience to God is one of the greatest virtues we can cultivate in our life. Jesus himself was obedient to the will and plan of the Father to save the world. Jesus obediently accepted death on the Cross for the forgiveness of our sins. Will we be obedient to God in our every day life, especially when it calls forth a sacrifice on our part? Let us pray for the grace to be like the man in the gospel who listened to Jesus and was healed. Lord, take away our hard heart and give us a courageous heart to obediently pick up our daily cross and follow you.

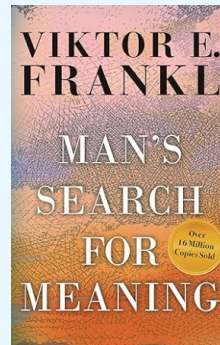

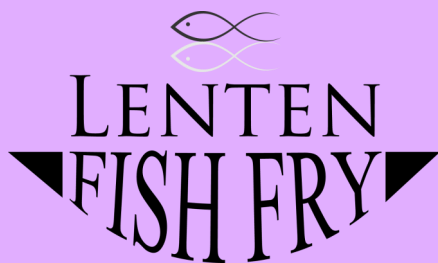

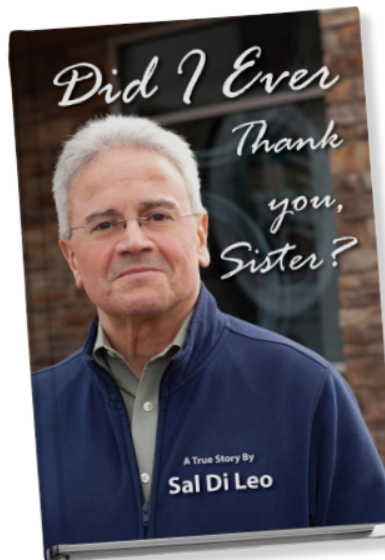
