From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday is known as "Good Shepherd Sunday". This Sunday's brief gospel is as follows: "Jesus said: My Sheep hear my voice; I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish. No one can take them out of my hand. My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than all, and no one can take them out of the Father's hand. The Father and I are one." There is something so comforting and reassuring about this passage. Especially the fact the "no one can take them out of the Father's hand. The Father and I are one." God the Father's power is Jesus' power. God's love is Jesus' love. The Father and Jesus are united in their being and in their love for us. Jesus, the Good Shepherd, calls us with the voice of one who, like the Father, cares for us and wants to tend to our needs and hold us in his arms. I was noticing a picture in our school office this week, and speaking to one of the children who happened to be in the office at the time. It was a picture of Mary, holding Jesus in one arm and holding a cute little lamb in the other arm. The lamb represents that Jesus will grow up to be the "Lamb of God, who takes away the sins of the world," but it also reminds us that we represent the lamb and are held in the arms of our Blessed Mother Mary, just as we are held in the Lord's arms. I told the child, and tell each of you, "isn't it wonderful that our Blessed Mother holds us like that and loves us!" May is a special month to honor our Blessed Mother, and our earthly mother's. Happy Mother's Day!




