From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

The Ascension of the Lord is celebrated this Sunday. The Ascension took place forty days after the Resurrection of Jesus and commemorated Jesus returning to the Father. Ten days later, on the Feast of Pentecost (celebrated next Sunday), the Holy Spirit descended upon the Apostles gathered in the upper room. I often imagine in prayer what life was like with Jesus and the Apostles during those forty days before he ascended. I imagine there was a special closeness they experienced with Jesus in his risen body, and many wonderful experiences they had with Jesus. When we receive the Eucharist, we receive Jesus' risen body. When I receive Jesus in Holy Communion, I feel close to Him, much like I imagine those disciples did during those forty days. Jesus told the disciples he must return to the Father so that the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, could come and teach them and lead them into all truth. The Holy Spirit exists in our Church today, and teaches and speaks through the Magisterium of the Church, that is, all the Bishops in union with our Pope, passing on the teachings and faith of Jesus. Let us pray for one another to listen to and follow the Holy Spirit working and living in our Church and in our hearts.

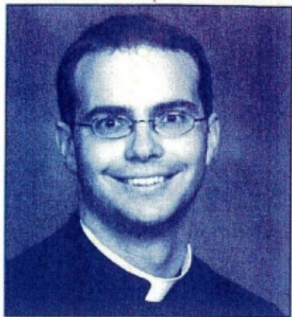

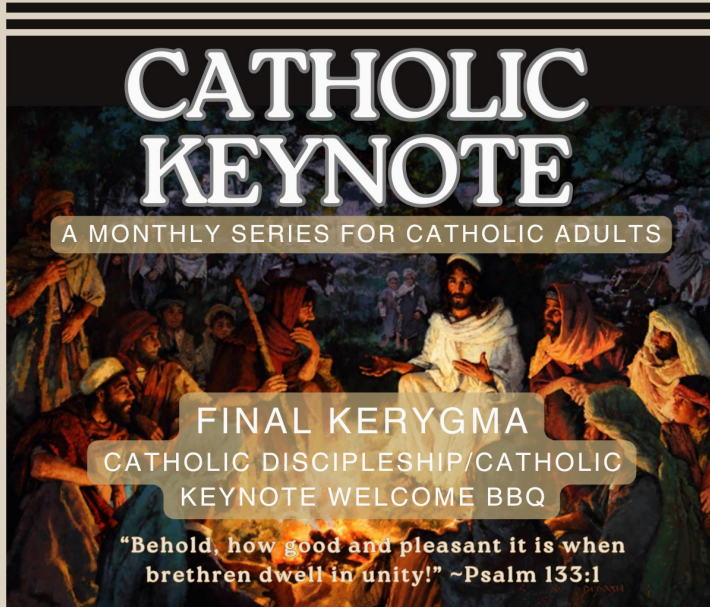
