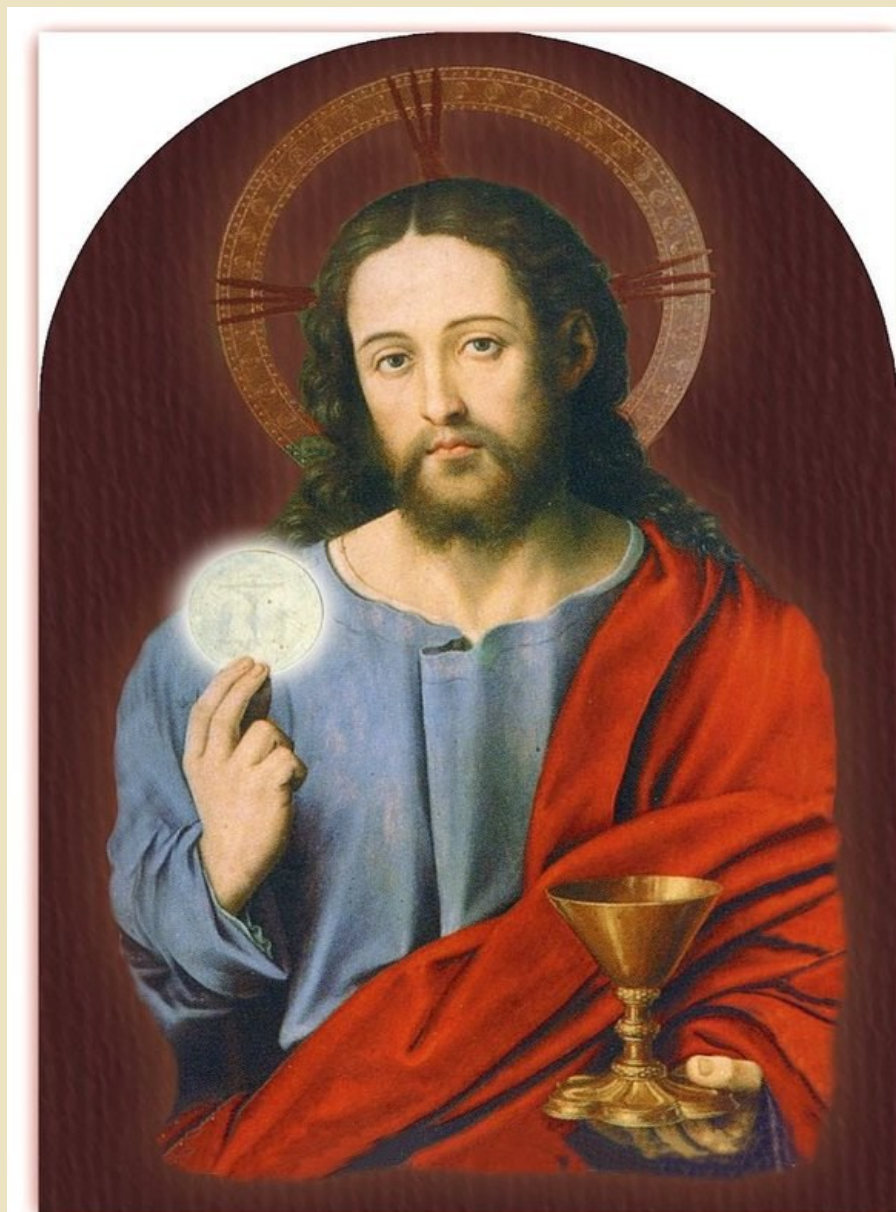

From the Pastor's Desk

The Solemnity of Corpus Christi celebrates the Real Presence of Jesus Christ - Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity - in the Holy Eucharist. It was not instituted to mark a historical event, but to adore a perpetual mystery: Christ hidden under the veils of bread and wine. Its origins trace back to the 13th century through the visions of St. Juliana of Liège, a Norbertine nun who saw in mystical visions that the Church lacked a solemnity dedicated solely to the Blessed Sacrament. Her spiritual insight inspired the local bishop to institute Corpus Christi in Liège in 1246, which then inspired Pope Urban IV to extend the feast to the universal Church. To articulate its theological richness, he commissioned St. Thomas Aquinas to compose its liturgical texts and hymns, which is also customarily used as adoration hymns. Corpus Christi reveals the Church's greatest treasure - not a doctrine alone, but Christ Himself, present in the Most Holy Eucharist.

Around the same time, the Eucharistic Miracle of Bolsena, in which a consecrated Host bled onto the corporal during Mass, served to affirm the Real Presence and the need for this solemn celebration.

A defining element of Corpus Christi is the public Eucharistic procession, where the consecrated Host is carried through the streets in a monstrance, uniting theology with visible, communal worship that the Church has enriched with special graces: "A plenary indulgence is granted to the faithful who devoutly participate in a solemn Eucharistic procession, held inside or outside a church, of greatest importance on the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ." ~Pope Leo XIV, Indulgence 7.1.3

JUNE Month of the Sacred Heart

The Month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus

Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus is one of the most popular Catholic devotions. Although it was beloved in previous centuries, Jesus appeared to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque in 1673, showing her a vision of the now-famous image of His Sacred Heart, surrounded by flames. He said to her: "My Heart is so full of love for men that It can no longer contain the flames of Its burning love. I must discover to men the treasures of My Heart and save them from perdition." She was given the special mission to spread devotion to His Sacred Heart throughout the Church. Jesus gave St. Margaret Mary many promises associated with this devotion, and requested that a feast day in honor of His Sacred Heart be instituted on the Friday after the Octave of Corpus Christi. In 1856, the Feast of the Sacred Heart was spread to the Universal Church, and in 1899 Pope Leo XIII solemnly consecrated all mankind to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, calling it "the great act" of his pontificate.

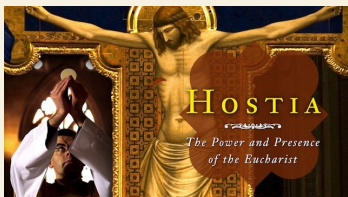
Emmaus Retreat

Dive Deeper into knowing the person of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. As a response to the Eucharistic Revival inaugurated by The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops, the Bismarck Diocese has partnered with University of Mary to bring a team of college students on fire to evangelize, to your city and offer a deep Eucharistic Retreat experience. The mission of these retreats is to provide a space where young people can experience the love of God in a renewed and transformative way. The title Emmaus is derived from chapter 24 of Luke's gospel—where Jesus draws near to His discouraged disciples. Jesus' model of evangelization in this gospel account is one we seek to follow through these retreats.

The Emmaus Youth retreats are led by the University of Mary Ministry team and the Bismarck Diocese. The retreats will feature talks, activities, music, Eucharistic Adoration, Mass, and fellowship with other young Catholics. There will be 5 different retreats, 1 in each deanery. The retreat is open to youth grades 6-9 and students preparing to receive the sacrament of Confirmation.
