From the Pastor's Desk

In his 1884 encyclical Humanum Genus, Pope Leo XIII offered the world a strong prophetic warning of the dangerous secular ideologies of his day, the implications of which we still feel deeply in civil society. He illuminates hidden agendas to undermine the very foundations of Christian civilization. At the heart of his concern is a worldview rooted in naturalism - a philosophy that denies divine revelation, the authority of the Church, and the supernatural order. This secular orientation, the Pope contends, leads society away from truth and virtue, replacing eternal values with relativism, materialism, and absolute licentious moral autonomy divorced from goodness, truth, beauty, and self-sacrificial love. By advocating for the separation of Church and State, the Church would be marginalized from public life and thus strip society of its spiritual foundation. This shift does not lead to neutrality, Leo XIII insists, but to the elevation of secularism as a quasi-religion, hostile to the Catholic faith and destructive to the moral conscience of nations insistent on religious indifferentism, breeding confusion and apathy in matters of ultimate concern.

Ultimately, Pope Leo XIII views naturalism as a deliberate attempt to restructure civilization on purely human terms, displacing the Church's formative role in shaping just laws, moral citizens, and the common good. He asserts that social regeneration is only possible through a return to Christ and the social kingship of God. The faithful are called to resist the seductive appeal of secular ideologies, to fortify themselves in Catholic truth, and to engage in public life as witnesses to the Gospel. Humanum Genus is a clarion call: society cannot flourish if it excludes God. The Church must reclaim her rightful role as the moral compass of civilization.

Movie Night



This film uses creative license in telling the story of Fr. Gregor Mendel. Some scenes may not be suitable for all audiences. Parental guidance is suggested.

This film tells the inspiring story of Gregor Mendel (1822 - 1884), who is considered the father of modern genetics, a science that changed the world. He was a Catholic priest and Augustinian monk who lived in the nineteenth century in the Austro-Hungarian Empire.

Starring Christopher Lambert as Mendel, the movie reveals how he combined his vocation as a priest and training as a scientist to impact the world by courageously following his passion for the truth. From the beginning he realized that his great scientific discovery could be used in a wrong way, and he sought the help of a benefactor and friend, the princess Hanna von Limburg, who supported him in his work and vocation, and helped spread the knowledge of his discovery around the world.

Mendel was a man of contemplation and of action, a dedicated priest and visionary scientist who is an important witness for contemporary society on how faith and science are not in conflict with each other. Mendel also struggled to change the fiscal policy applied to the monasteries in his country and even asked for the Pope's help on this issue.

The film tells how he was invited by Pope Pius IX to the Vatican where they shared their views about the relationship of faith and science. The Pope recognizes the important scientific contribution of Father Mendel and speaks the prophetic words to him, "Father Mendel, your discovery will survive you and it will survive all of us."
