

## From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday is the Feast of Pentecost, when we commemorate the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles and Mary. This took place ten days after the Ascension while the disciples were gathered. Tongues as of fire came to rest upon them and they were enabled to speak and understand new languages and all could understand them speaking of the mighty acts of God in their own language. This is the undoing of what took place at the Tower of Bable in the Book of Genesis, when God confused the languages of the people due to their pride, and they were unable to finish the tower they were building in opposition to God. Now God unites the languages of the people so all can understand the Gospel, repent, and follow Jesus who is the way, the truth, and the life. What is it in our life that seems confused and separated from God's plan? Ask God to restore your heart and strengthen, through his Spirit, the direction of your life. Call upon the Holy Spirit using the following prayer if you find it helpful: By St. Augustine: "Breathe in me, O Holy Spirit, that my thoughts may all be holy. Act in me, O Holy Spirit, that my work, too, may be holy. Draw my heart, O Holy Spirit, that I love but what is holy. Strengthen me, O Holy Spirit, to defend all that is holy. Guard me, then, O Holy Spirit, that I always may be holy. Amen."
