From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

Last week, during my homily, I read a prayer card that was used by a priest who came to my parish as a child to give a mission. It is called the "Miracle Prayer". My mom was healed from a particular ailment of headaches (though not all her physical pains were healed), and my dad was healed from the weight of stresses he was carrying. So many people asked for the prayer after Mass that I decided to share it with you here: MIRACLE PRAY-ER "Lord Jesus, I come before you, just as I am. I am sorry for my sins, I repent of my sins, please forgive me. In your name, I forgive all others for what they have done against me. I renounce satan, the evil spirits and all their works. I give you my entire self. Lord Jesus, now and forever, I invite you into my life Jesus, I accept you as my Lord, God, and Saviour. Heal me, change me, strengthen me in body, soul and spirit.

Come, Lord Jesus, cover me with your precious blood, and fill me with your Holy Spirit, I Love You Lord Jesus. I Praise You Jesus. I Thank You Jesus. I shall follow you every day of my life. Amen.

Mary, my mother, Queen of Peace, St. Peregrine, the cancer saint, all you Angels and Saints please help me. Amen.

On the bottom of the prayer card it gave an instruction that is just as important as the prayer itself. It read: Say this Prayer faithfully, no matter how you feel, when you come to the point where you sincerely mean each word, with all your heart, something good spiritually will happen to you. You will experience Jesus, and HE will change your whole life in a very special way. You will see."


