

Dear Parishioners,

Our group of eleven service team members recently returned from a mission trip in Antigua, Guatemala. We worked with the God's Child Project building homes for the poor, assisting with the sick and malnourished children in Casa Jackson Hospital at the Dreamer Center, the headquarters of God's Child in Antigua, in addition to visiting the after school program run by the Center. 
