From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

Our group of eleven service team members recently returned from a mission trip in Antigua, Guatemala. We worked with the God's Child Project building homes for the poor, assisting with the sick and malnourished children in Casa Jackson Hospital at the Dreamer Center, the headquarters of God's Child in Antigua, in addition to visiting the after school program run by the Center. We were also able to experience some of the culture of the area. It was a life-changing experience and each member of the group was touched by the opportunity. I made the same trip about 23 years ago, but doing so once again reminded me of the continual need to reach out and support those in need. It helped me to appreciate more deeply the simple and basic amenities we enjoy and take for granted. So many struggle to find housing, put food on the table, and provide for an education for their children. Supporting an organization such as the God's Child Project, or similar organizations such as Cross Catholic Outreach or our African Mission in Kenya, are some ways we can be of assistance. Thank you to those of you who financially supported the young members of our group to make it possible for them to have this experience. In the near future, likely after a 5pm Saturday Mass, some members of our group will give a short presentation in O'Neill Hall for anyone interested in hearing about the trip. I pray for you and your families daily, please pray for me.

Emmaus Retreat

Dive Deeper into knowing the person of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. As a response to the Eucharistic Revival inaugurated by The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops, the Bismarck Diocese has partnered with University of Mary to bring a team of college students on fire to evangelize, to your city and offer a deep Eucharistic Retreat experience. The mission of these retreats is to provide a space where young people can experience the love of God in a renewed and transformative way. The title Emmaus is derived from chapter 24 of Luke's gospel— where Jesus draws near to His discouraged disciples.
