From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

On Saturday, September 20th at 10:00 a.m., we plan to host a special Mass of Anointing of the Sick here at St. Joe's. This is a deanery wide Mass to celebrate the Jubilee Year of Hope. God's mercy comes to us through this great Sacrament. The Anointing of the Sick (one of the 7 sacraments of the Catholic Church) is for those who are gravely ill (of any age) and/or experience the infirmity of old age. All are invited to participate in this Mass, even if you will not be Anointed. The Anointing will take place after the homily and many priests will be available to assist. If you have a question as to whether you are eligible to receive an Anointing, please ask me and I will be happy to help you make that discernment. Bishop Kagan has asked each deanery to offer an Anointing Mass sometime during this current Jubilee Year of Hope. During this Jubilee Year we look to God to renew our hope and trust in him and his mercy for us. The Anointing of the Sick derives from the Sacred Scriptures, namely, the Book of James, which makes reference to calling upon the priests to come and pray over and anoint those who are sick, so they may be healed. Sometimes physical healings take place during Anointings, often times spiritual healings take place, especially when the disposition of the person receiving the Sacrament is one of deep trust in God's power and acceptance of his will in your life. I hope you can join us!




