

From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

In the Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius of Loyola (1491-1556), a book that serves as a guide for a retreat director, one of the first things St. Ignatius teaches is the "Principal and Foundation" of the Exercises. The text of this "principal and foundation" points to the goal of the spiritual life, which is to live with God forever. It describes the disposition necessary to grow in the spiritual life. Here is the text for your prayerful reflection: "Man is created to praise, reverence, and serve God our Lord, and by this means to save his soul. All other things on the face of the earth are created for man to help him in attaining the end for which he is created. From this it follows that man is to use these things to the extent that they help him to attain his end, and he must rid himself of them in so far as they prove a hindrance to him. We must make ourselves indifferent to all created things ... not preferring health to sickness, riches to poverty, honor to dishonor, a long life to a short life, provided only that we desire and choose what is most conducive to the end for which we are created." In other words, seek God in all things and see every circumstance as an opportunity to say yes to God's plan of redeeming you.
