

From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

On Saturday, October 4th at 7pm at the Grand Theatre in Williston the screening of the new movie "Hazel" will be showing. It is the true story of Hazel Miner - a beautiful story of Christ-like sacrifice with strong Christian themes. Hazel was a 16-year old farm girl who saved her little brother and sister during a white-out blizzard in 1920. This is a North Dakota "saint" story and I encourage you to attend if you can. It will inspire you.

On Sunday, October 12th at 4pm in O'Neill Hall the parish will host a seminar "Get Your Affairs In Order" about making end-of-life plans. David Tamisea from the ND Catholic Conference will talk about Health Care directives from a Catholic perspective. Seth Coughlin will speak about how to go about funeral planning arrangements. Tom Kalil will touch on how you can be prepared to leave your legacy to your family and to our parish or other charitable organizations. I encourage you to attend!

I thank you for your generosity of service and financial giving to our parish. I invite you to continue your generosity of your time, talent, and treasure. If you desire to be involved in parish ministry in some way, please contact the parish office and we can discuss. If you want to set up monthly online parish giving you can use the QR code located in the weekly bulletin and/or on the pew cards. This is an easy and streamlined way to set up a regular gift to the parish and/or school. If you have not increased your parish giving for some time, I invite you to consider raising it this year by a certain dollar amount or percentage. Pray about it and God will help you know how to best give. I once heard a quote about sacrificial giving that went, "You can give without loving, but you cannot love without giving." Love calls forth sacrifice in our lives. A sacrificial gift is pleasing to God and is a blessing to others, just as to the gift-giver. I also encourage you to consider making a tax-deductible gift to either the School Endowment (currently approximately \$5 million dollar Endowment, we use only the interest) or the Parish Endowment (currently approximately \$250,000, only interest used). We also have "Employee Benefits" Agency Fund, and a "Teacher Salary Enhancement" Agency Fund to which you may make a tax-deductible gift. All of these Endowments/Agency Funds are pooled in the Catholic Foundation of Western North Dakota, which only makes investments that are morally and socially responsible.

If you wish to leave the parish in your will, we welcome that and can help direct you on how to go about setting it up. The October 12th seminar will be helpful to anyone wishing to learn more about leaving a legacy to those you love, and I know so many of you love the parish deeply and wish to leave something for the future generations of the parish. Personally, I have my will set up to leave most of my earthly treasure (which isn't much, but it's something:) to go to the parish at which I am assigned when I die. Well...let's hope that is not so soon! But I have it planned and can rest in peace at night knowing that my treasures will go to those I love the most...my parishioners!




