




**Women's Study Group**

## Biography of Carlo Acutis

Carlo Acutis was born in London in 1991 and grew up in Milan, Italy. At the age of seven, he developed a deep devotion to the Eucharist, describing it as “my highway to Heaven.” He attended Mass daily, went to confession regularly, and prayed the rosary. Passionate about technology, he taught himself programming and web design, using those skills to evangelize. He created the famous [exhibition on Eucharistic miracles](#) (136 documented cases) which continues to travel the world today, a global project he launched before his death in 2006 at the age of 15 from leukemia.

Beyond technology, Carlo lived a faith rooted in everyday life. He went to confession frequently, helped classmates in need, and took part in pilgrimages to Lourdes and Fatima. During his vacations, he dedicated time to volunteering, and in his later years, he designed a website for his parish to share catechetical materials and promote parish activities.

Carlo often repeated this phrase to inspire young people to live a life of faith and love for others

Beatified in 2020 thanks to a miracle in Brazil, a second miracle, the healing of a young Costa Rican woman after a serious accident, was confirmed in 2024, paving his way to the altars. His canonization was announced by Pope Leo XIV during his first public consistory, scheduled for 7 September 2025, the same date set for the canonization of Pier Giorgio Frassati.

## Biography of Pier Giorgio Frassati

Born in Turin in 1901, Pier Giorgio stood out for the consistency between his faith and his actions. He attended Mass daily, cared for the sick and needy through the St. Vincent de Paul Society and Catholic Action, and worked tirelessly for social justice. His mountain climbs were more than a hobby; they were moments of prayer, joy, and true friendship. St. John Paul II would later call him “the man of the Beatitudes” because he lived them so fully, making Pier Giorgio a model for young Christians everywhere.

**To the heights!**

This simple phrase, written under a photo from one of his alpine adventures, sums up his approach to faith and life

In 1925, at the age of 24, he died suddenly from polio, contracted during a week of intense service to the sick. Two miracles have been attributed to his intercession, the most recent being the unexplained healing of an American seminarian with a ruptured Achilles tendon. On September 7, 2025, Pier Giorgio Frassati will be canonized alongside Carlo Acutis by Pope Leo XIV. During the announcement, the Pope highlighted his life of Eucharistic devotion and incarnate charity as a model for everyone, not only the young.
