From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

Jesus begins his Sermon on the Mount with the beatitudes, which we hear in this Sunday's Gospel. Each beatitude draws us into a particular aspect of God's nature and deeper into union with him. The first beatitude, "Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven," reminds us that poverty is not always directly tied to material possessions. One can be materially poor but still not poor in spirit and vice versa. All is a gift from God.
