

### From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday is the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord, which concludes the liturgical season of Christmas. The Baptism is one of the "Epiphanies" or "Revelations/Manifestations" of Jesus' divinity. After Jesus' baptism by John in the Jordan the Father's voice from heaven says, "You are my Beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased." Jesus is God's son. You and I through our baptism also become daughters and sons of God, in whom he is well pleased. Our baptism takes away Original Sin inherited from Adam and Eve's first sin, and opens the gates of heaven to us. Baptism of adults, and children above the age of reason, also removes personal sins. John the Baptist called for a baptism of repentance. Jesus was sinless and had no need of repentance or of baptism, yet Jesus had John baptize him in order that the waters of our baptism become holy and effective through the life, death and resurrection of Jesus. The life, death, and resurrection of Jesus is also known as the Paschal Mystery and is what is celebrated and "made present again", that is, memorialized, at each and every celebration of Mass. At the Last Supper, Jesus told his disciples to "Do this in memory of me" and that is why we celebrate Mass on a daily basis. The Mass, though not the first Sacrament we receive (Baptism is always first), is the most important and is "the source and summit of the Catholic Faith" as is taught by the Church. I pray that God will call you and lead you to the Sacraments if you have not yet received them. Let me or the parish office know if you have any sacramental questions and we would be happy to answer. God bless your week!


