### From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

John the Baptist was told by the one (God) who sent him to baptize with water, "On whomever you see the Spirit come down and remain, he is the one who will baptize with the Holy Spirit". John points out "the one", who is Jesus, when he comes to be baptized. John says those same words the priest says just before Holy Communion at Mass, "Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world." The reason John came baptizing was to make the Messiah (Jesus) known to the people of God. This past Monday we began as a parish watching and discussing The Rescue Project videos led by Fr. John Ricardo. By the way, all of you (14 years and older) are welcome to attend those sessions on the next seven Monday nights beginning at 5:15pm in O'Neill Hall. In the first session, Fr. Ricardo spoke of the power of the Gospel, the good news, which we can carry to others. We can be like the "mailman" who carries the message to others, much like John the Baptist does in the Gospel by pointing out Jesus as the Lamb of God, a term for the sacrificial Savior. Lambs were sacrificed in the Temple. The sins of the people were laid upon the lamb, who was subsequently sacrificed and its blood sprinkled upon the people. Jesus takes the place of the sacrificial lamb, and it is his Body and Blood which saves us, which we receive in the Eucharist. This is the Good News, the Gospel, which John points out. May we heed his message and follow our Savior wherever he leads.



## SACRED LITURGY: HOLY DEATH

"Is any one among you suffering? Let him pray. Is any cheerful? Let him sing praise. Is any among you sick? Let him call for the priests of the Church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord; and the prayer of faith will save the sick man, and the Lord will raise him up; and if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven. Therefore, confess your sins to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous man has great power in its effects." -James 5:13-16

If there is ever a time to assist others in exercising the virtues of faith, hope, and charity with grace for salvation and sanctification, it is at the hour of death. The Catholic Church has so many gifts to give in this inevitable process to assist the faithful in having a proper custody of one's soul throughout life, especially before one's particular judgment which will happen immediately after death. Fr. Wanner will be giving a full presentation about having a Holy Death from the first moment one begins to be in danger of death all the way to having a Holy RIP Burial. Some of the elements of a Holy Death can be planned in advance and may depend on other people. Subtopics will include but not be limited to the following: First Anointing, Subsequent Anointings, Last Rites, Medical Considerations, Mystery of Death, Caring for the Bodies of the Dead, Funeral Arrangements, Funeral Vigil, Funeral Mass, Catholic RIP Burial, Praying for those in Purgatory, Relics/Incorruptible Saints etc.


