From the Pastor’s Desk

In his Encyclical *Satis Cognitum* #10, Pope Leo XIII speaks of the Catholic Church as a Divine Society in relation to the state. According to Aristotle’s *Politics*, man is relational, powerful, and political by nature, and so Aristotle considers society as a real extension of man’s relational nature essential for human flourishing. Thus, neglecting to relate properly according to our political rights to avoid communication, conflict, or persecution can gravely harm the common good with vices like misunderstanding, faintheartedness, cowardice, and inner fragility. Of course, Christians confidently know that everything natural - including all authority on earth - ultimately comes from God and is ordered back to his glory in the order of grace, which is necessary to fulfill human nature. According to St. Augustine, the City of Man must be in relationship with the City of God for its perfection in the Kingdom of Heaven. They cannot be divorced (cf. CSDC 425). Citizens of Heaven are not called to vitiate human freedom by tolerance of pernicious evil, error, and ugliness. God never left anyone’s ultimate happiness up to the autonomous judgement of private individuals, but rather entrusted it to the Magisterium exclusively. The Catholic Church is a society divine in its origin and supernatural in its end. As a soul relates to its body, so too Catholicism must animate a fullness of life for the world. With her Social Doctrine, the Church is political by nature because mankind is political by nature and by grace. To pursue a perfect society, our friendly relationships will need to transcend the strict secular Americanism and rigorous religious toleration entrenched in our current culture.






