Dear Parishioners,

In this weekend's Gospel Jesus speaks of his disciples as the "salt of the earth" and the "light of the world." As Jesus' disciples of today, you are "salt" and "light". Salt seasons and preserves our food. Light from a lamp placed on a lampstand gives light for all to see, just as the light of our faith in Christ may cause others to see your good deeds and glorify the heavenly Father.
