My Beloved Brothers and Sisters;

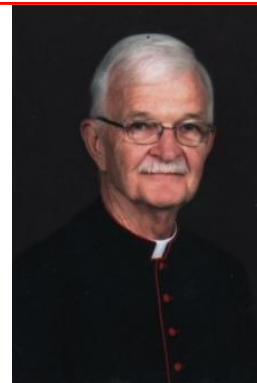

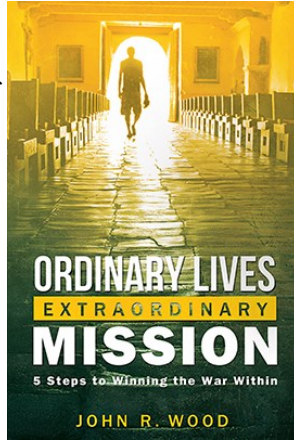
