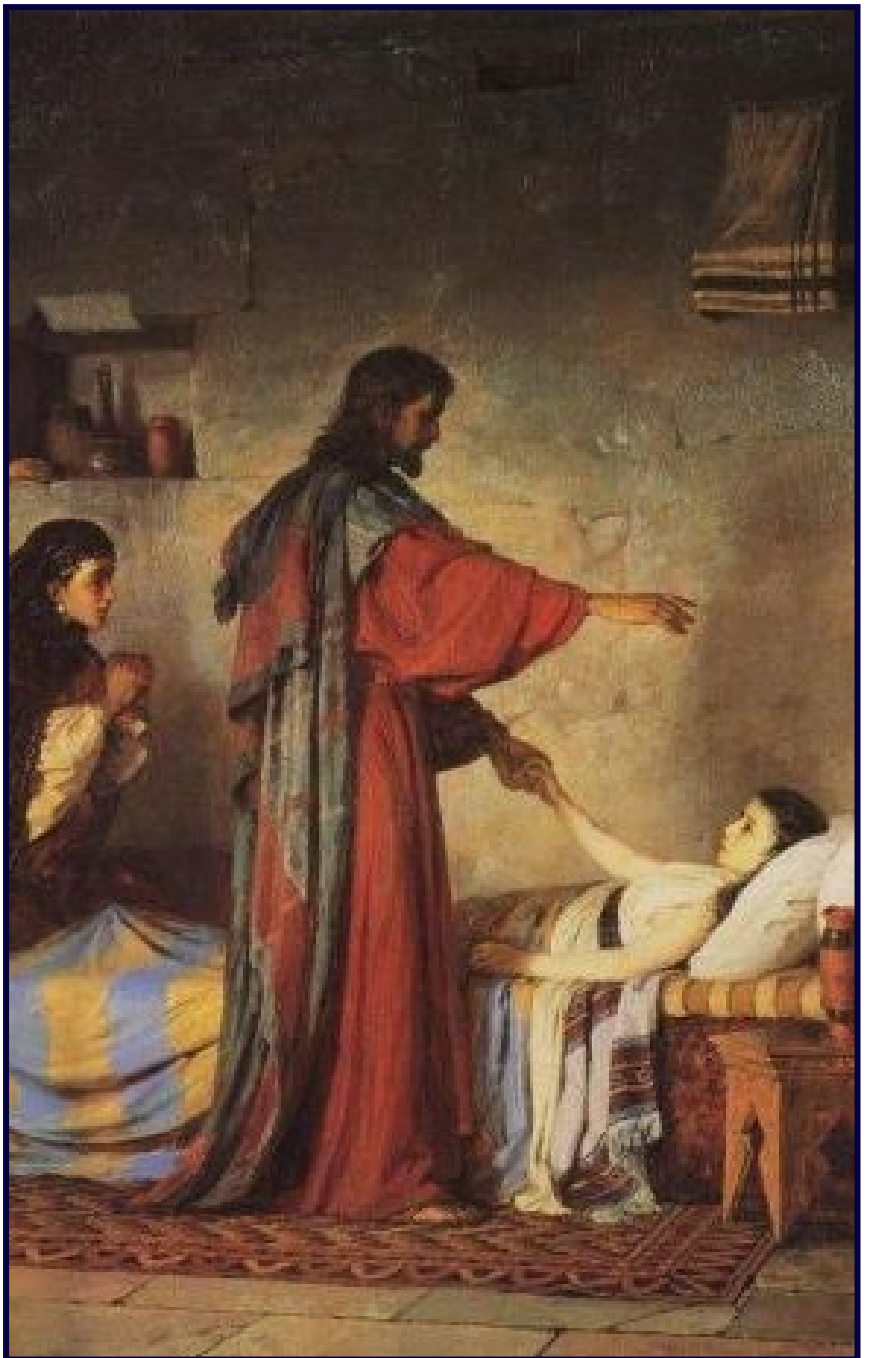

Role Title: Facilities Manager

Role Description: The Facilities Manager provides leadership and direction to the overall plant maintenance. In addition, the Facilities Manager will perform daily maintenance checks as well as basic repairs across the plant as well as general maintenance both inside and outside. Finally, the Facilities Manager will maintain maintenance records and schedule major maintenance and repairs as needed and approved per the Parish Expenditure Policy. The Facilities Manager will direct and oversee the duties of the part-time Custodian.

Overall the Facilities Manager ensures the continuity of production operations and collaborates with other departments/ministries to ensure overall success of the parish. The Facilities Manager reports directly to the Pastor. This is a full-time salary role with pension contributions and medical benefits.

Role Responsibilities:

- **Leadership and Direction:**
 - o Supervise construction, improvement and repair events, monitor progress and manage risks and issues. Provide status reports to Pastor, Business Manager and Finance Council as needed.
 - o Solicit, review and make recommendations on bids and quotes and negotiate contracts. This should adhere to the Quote Process and should be reviewed with the Business Manager. In addition, recommendations should comply with the Parish Expenditure Policy.
 - o Manage, provide guidance and work closely with the part-time Custodian.
 - o Research and evaluate new equipment and processes to improve the cost efficiency and effectiveness of operations.
 - o Collaborate with Archdiocese Risk Management and Catholic Mutual to ensure plant compliance.
 - o Work with staff personnel, ministries, volunteers and hired services to address their needs.
 - o Weekly check-in with Business Manager to discuss on-going as well as new and/or proposed projects. Provide weekly notes to Pastor and Finance Council.
- **Maintenance Duties:**
 - o Perform facilities maintenance and repairs including electrical, plumbing, physical structures to buildings, heating ventilation, air conditioning, general housekeeping and maintaining plant grounds.
 - o Perform preventative maintenance and identify and remedy facility and grounds issues which require attention.
 - o Monitor safety and security of the campus buildings and grounds. Ensure all city permits are current.
 - o Directs and helps with room set-up of furniture, supplies, etc. for miscellaneous parish events.

- o Oversee management of phone system, computers and internet systems and other business machines.
- o Work flexible and extended hours when needed and may include evenings, weekends and special occasions.

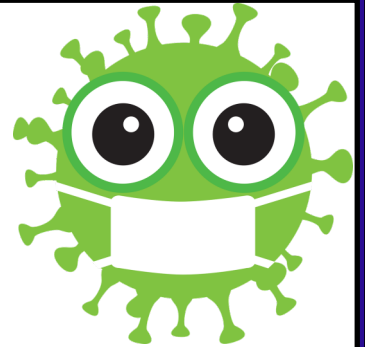
- o Ensure adequate inventory of janitorial and kitchen supplies and make request of needed supplies to Business Manager.
- o Manages and maintains maintenance records for the plant.
- o Participate in annual parish performance management process.
- o Attend parish staff meetings.
- o Lead and develop the annual budget for plant operations.

 - o Must be trained in HVAC, electrical and plumbing and able to perform basic repairs.
 - o Bi-lingual (Spanish and English desired)
 - o Very capable of prioritizing and discussing prioritization; remain flexible
 - o Well organized to handle multiple tasks; detailed oriented
 - o Excellent written and verbal skills
 - o Time management is crucial with an ability to plan and organize
 - o Valid TDL
 - o Basic understanding of the budgeting concept and comparison of actuals to budget.

The positions are as follows:

Sanitizing and Guidance Stations (3 people per Mass)

Greet people arriving for the mass and make sure they have a mask, they properly utilize the hand sanitizer before proceeding, and explain the procedures for entering the building.

Count people who are entering the church so we maintain below 25% capacity

Guide (direct) people arriving to the entry door and Sanitizing station.

Cleaning Pews after Service (4 people per Mass)

Use the solution and spray bottles provided by the Church to disinfect each of the pews that could be used (only 25% are available) by spraying the spray on the pew. No wiping required. Spray door handles and other areas that are touched by visitors.

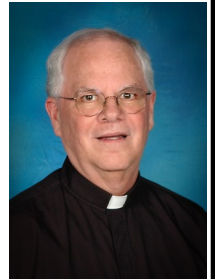

A message from Father Bill

Caution! :Phony emails, text messages and requests for gift cards.

There have been reports of phony email and text messages that appear to come from me requesting the purchase of gift cards. This is a scam (referred to as "phishing"). Do not purchase gift cards for such a request.



The message invokes strong emotions like greed or fear. Sensitive data, or money, is requested. Beware that even if the message appears to be from someone you know, it could be a hacker impersonating one of your trusted contacts. If there is doubt about the legitimacy of an email from a known sender, contact them using alternate means, such as a known phone number, to confirm the contents of the message.

¡Precaución! : Correos electrónicos falsos, mensajes de texto y solicitudes de tarjetas de regalo.

Ha habido informes de correos electrónicos falsos y mensajes de texto que parecen provenir de mí para solicitar la compra de tarjetas de regalo. Esta es una estafa (denominada "phishing"). No compre tarjetas de regalo para tal solicitud.

El mensaje invoca emociones fuertes como la codicia o el miedo. Se solicitan datos confidenciales o dinero. Tenga en cuenta que incluso si el mensaje parece ser de alguien que usted conoce, podría ser un hacker que se hace pasar por uno de sus contactos de confianza. Si hay dudas sobre la legitimidad de un correo electrónico de un remitente conocido, comuníquese con ellos utilizando medios alternativos, como un número de teléfono conocido, para confirmar el contenido del mensaje.

Did You Know?

Q. Why is the congregation asked to sing during Mass?

A. Participation. The Holy Mother Church asks for active participation within the gathered assembly. While there are many forms of participation that include the liturgical assembly, participation is most important with acclamations, responses, and singing. The Church document, *Sing to the Lord*, teaches us that, "The quality of our participation in such sung praise comes less from our vocal ability than from the desire of our hearts to sing together of our love for God...Participation in the Sacred Liturgy both expresses and strengthens the faith that is in us."

(STTL Participation 13). The Church asks for, and develops, the continuation and support of singing psalms, spiritual songs and hymns in the Liturgy. St. Augustine inspires us with his words, "He who sings prays twice."

A. Participación. La Santa Madre Iglesia pide una participación activa dentro de la asamblea reunida. Si bien hay muchas formas de participación que incluyen la asamblea litúrgica, la participación es más importante con aclamaciones, respuestas y cantos. El documento de la Iglesia, *Canemos al Señor*, nos enseña que, "La calidad de nuestra participación en tales alabanzas proviene menos de nuestra habilidad vocal que del deseo de nuestros corazones de cantar juntos de nuestro amor por Dios... La participación en la Sagrada Liturgia expresa y fortalece la fe que hay en nosotros." (Participación STTL 13). La Iglesia pide y desarrolla la continuación y el apoyo de cantar salmos, canciones espirituales e himnos en la Liturgia. San Agustín nos inspira con sus palabras: "El que canta ora dos veces".

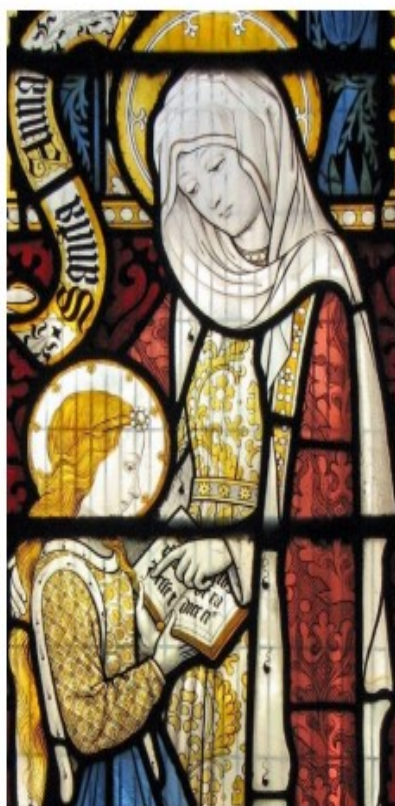

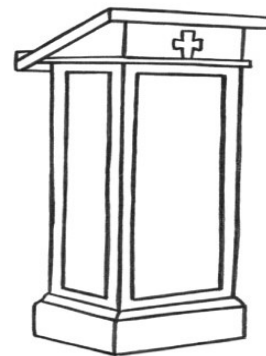

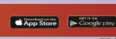
