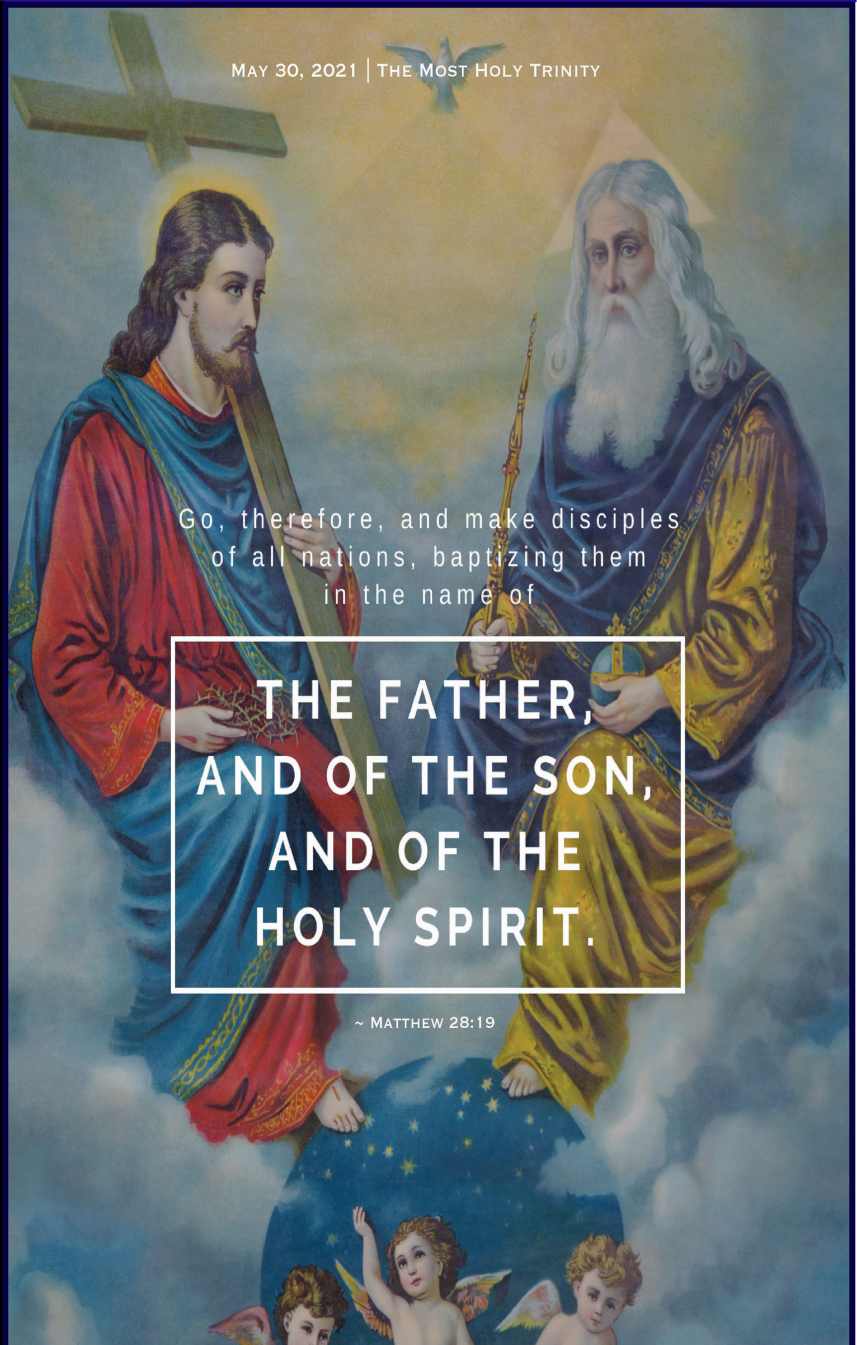

Reflection

THE MYSTERY OF THE BLESSED TRINITY

Today we celebrate the solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. The Church sets aside this Sunday to focus our attention on the mystery of the Blessed Trinity, God who is one, but three persons—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

The first reading from Deuteronomy emphasizes both God's awesome greatness and amazing nearness. It might seem beyond belief, but the God of all creation speaks to us, protects us, and guides us. The second reading from Saint Paul's Letter to the Romans describes how we are to relate to the three persons who are one God. We are led by the Spirit to meet God the Father as adopted children. Our adoption is such that we are even heirs with our brother, Christ, the second person of the Trinity, in whose sufferings we must also share. In Matthew's Gospel, Jesus speaks with his authority as God and sends us to teach and baptize in the name of the Trinity. Copyright © J. S. Paluch Co.

EL MISTERIO DE LA SANTÍSIMA TRINIDAD

Hoy celebramos la solemnidad de la Santísima Trinidad. La Iglesia dedica este domingo a centrar nuestra atención en el misterio de la Santísima Trinidad, Dios, que es uno, en tres personas: Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo.

La primera lectura de Deuteronomio hace énfasis en la grandeza imponente de Dios y su cercanía asombrosa. Puede parecer increíble, pero el Dios de toda la creación nos habla, nos protege y nos guía. La segunda lectura, tomada de la carta de San Pablo a los Romanos, describe la forma en que se relacionan las tres personas que son un solo Dios. El Espíritu nos guía para cumplir con Dios Padre como hijos adoptivos. Nuestra adopción es tal que somos incluso los herederos de nuestro hermano, Cristo, la segunda persona de la Trinidad, cuyos sufrimientos también debemos compartir. En el Evangelio según San Mateo, Jesús habla con la autoridad de Dios y nos envía a enseñar y bautizar en nombre de la Trinidad.

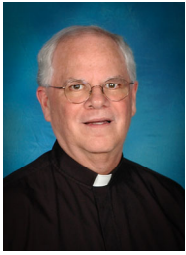

Pastor's Chronicle



Cardinal DiNardo has modified the pandemic procedures for the celebrations of liturgical parish gatherings due to the pandemic situations being greatly improved.

- Social distancing no longer necessary during liturgical celebration. Parishes may be filled with 100% capacity.
- Masks will not be required, but they are encouraged.
- The temporary suspension of receiving Holy Communion on the tongue is removed. Holy Communion may be received on the tongue, or in the hand, at the communicant's discretion.
- Those administering Holy Communion must take care to properly purify and sanitize their hands before distributing.
- The temporary suspension of receiving Holy Communion under the appearance of wine from a common chalice remains in effect.
- The use of holy water fonts continues to be suspended.
- Surfaces are to be cleaned thoroughly between liturgies and at the end of the day.
- Making hand sanitizer available at the entrances of the church is recommended. Those administering Holy Communion or handling sacred vessels should sanitize their hands appropriately during the liturgy.
- For the time being, the general dispensation from the Sunday obligation is in effect.

Cronica del Pastor

El cardenal DiNardo ha modificado los procedimientos pandémicos para las celebraciones de las reuniones litúrgicas parroquiales debido a que las situaciones pandémicas han mejorado.

- El distanciamiento social ya no es necesario durante la celebración litúrgica. Las parroquias pueden llenarse al 100% de su capacidad.
- No se requerirán máscaras, pero se recomiendan.
- Se elimina la suspensión temporal de recibir la Sagrada Comunión en la lengua. La Sagrada Comunión puede recibirse en la lengua o en la mano, a discreción del comulgante.
- Quienes administran la Sagrada Comunión deben tener cuidado de purificarse y desinfectarse adecuadamente las manos antes de distribuir.
- Se mantiene vigente la suspensión temporal de recibir la Sagrada Comunión bajo la apariencia de vino de un cáliz común.
- Continúa suspendido el uso de fuentes de agua bendita.
- Las superficies deben limpiarse a fondo entre liturgias y al final del día.
- Se recomienda disponer de desinfectante de manos en las entradas de la iglesia. Los que administran la Sagrada Comunión o manipulan los vasos sagrados deben desinfectarse las manos adecuadamente durante la liturgia.
- Por el momento, está en vigor la dispensa general de la obligación dominical.

The AECC is preparing for the 2021-2022 school year! Our program will hold a four-day program offered Tuesday - Friday. Registrants will have a choice of a 1/2 day or full day schedule, however, the Pre-K class will only be offered as a full day program. Also, the Young Two Year Old class is available for two days, on Tuesday and Thursday. To enroll a child or multiple children the registration form must be completed and returned with the non-refundable application fee of - \$250.00 for single family registration. For a multi-family the registration for each child is \$100.00 (check payable to All Saints Early Childhood Center (AECC)).

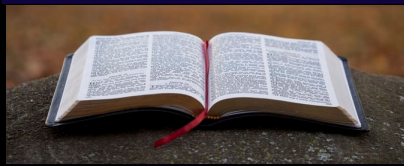

This ministry is comprised of individuals who assist, prior to and during each Funeral Mass, by setting up the Sacristy and the church with the necessary items for the celebration of the Funeral Mass or Memorial Mass.

This ministry is most rewarding as it provides the opportunity to offer solace and support to the Christian family and loved ones of the deceased when they need it most.

Most Funeral Masses take place on a weekday morning or occasionally on a Saturday morning. Team members are notified of upcoming funerals and asked to respond with their availability. A group of three or four are assigned to assist with a Funeral or Memorial Mass.

Ministry Duties

The Funeral ministers welcome the bereaved family members to the church and assist them as necessary with special requests. They work with the funeral home representatives to make the occasion proceed as smoothly as possible. There are occasions when the Funeral Minister will proclaim the readings for the family, assist the celebrant in administering the Body and Blood of Christ, and perform other duties as requested.

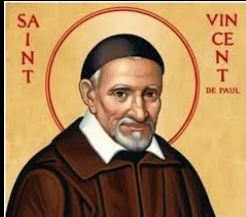

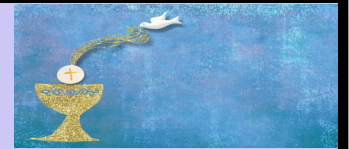

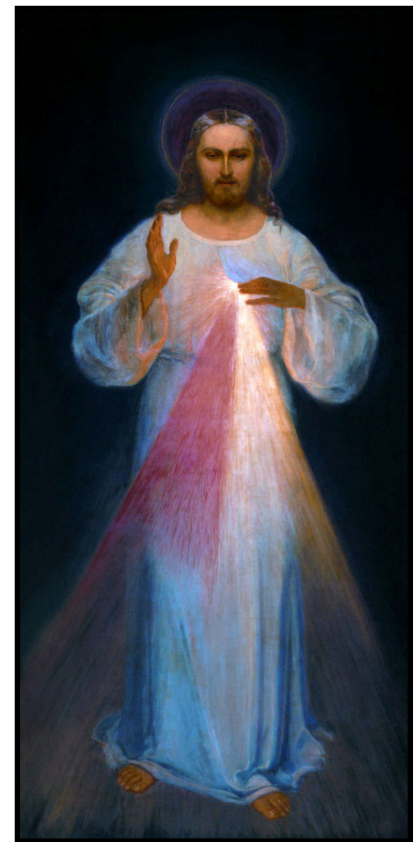
