LOVE AS GOD LOVES

Our Gospel today continues Jesus' Sermon on the Plain, in which we heard Luke's version of the Beatitudes. This week, Jesus gives us new "commandments," telling us how to live and act in the world as his disciples, rooted in the radical love of God for humanity. It reminds us of his later speech about loving one another as he loves us, in other words with a God-like love, the kind we see in today's psalm about God's mercy. How else could we do as Jesus tells us by loving our enemies, which seems impossible, until we remember that God gave us the example of Jesus, who is like God but also like us? David understands this merciful love when he spares the life of his enemy in the first reading. Finally, Paul tells us that we will become like Jesus if we act as he did, as God does.

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AMAR COMO DIOS AMA

En nuestro Evangelio de hoy, Jesús continua el Sermón del Llano, en el que escuchamos la versión de Lucas de las Bienaventuranzas. Esta semana, Jesús nos da nuevos "mandamientos", diciéndonos cómo vivir y comportarnos en el mundo como sus discípulos, enraizados en el amor radical de Dios por la humanidad. Nos recuerda su discurso posterior sobre cómo amarse los unos a los otros, en otras palabras, con un amor semejante al de Dios, el que vemos en el salmo de hoy sobre la misericordia de Dios. ¿De qué otra manera podríamos hacer lo que Jesús nos dice acerca de amar a nuestros enemigos? Lo cual parece imposible, hasta que recordamos que Dios nos dio el ejemplo de Jesús, quien es Dios, pero también es como nosotros. En la primera lectura, David comprende este amor misericordioso cuando perdona la vida de sus enemigos. Por último, Pablo nos dice que seremos como Jesús si actuamos como él, como Dios.

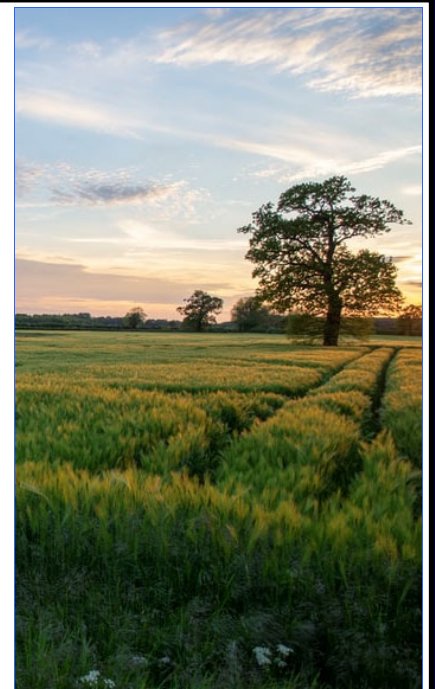

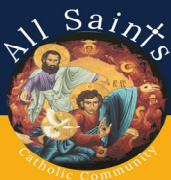

ALL SAINTS' SENIOR PROGRAM TO RE-OPEN IN SPRING 2022

All Saints' senior program, Third Age Learning Center (TALC), will re-open to seniors for an in-person ten-week Spring Semester on Monday, February 28th. The Spring Semester will close on Friday, May 13th.

Third Age Learning Center has been closed to in-person activities since March 2020 due to Covid-19/Variants concerns. Seniors previously enrolled in classes have been contacted by their instructors regarding returning to in-person classes and informing them of the guidelines for returning. There will be no seminars, bus trips or parties this spring. The goal of TALC is to provide a safe environment and safety/cleaning protocols will be in place during the semester. Seniors will be required to be vaccinated and wear masks in all common areas of the Third Age Learning Center building.

A take-out hot lunch program will be held Monday through Friday at 12 noon during the ten-week semester. A limited number of lunches will be prepared and seniors must call TALC at 713-248-1277 between 9 am and 10:30 am to place their order. Due to the rise in food costs, the hot lunch will be a nominal \$4 and correct change is requested as no change is given. Checks are also accepted made payable to All Saints Catholic Church. All lunches will be picked up in the Parish Hall from 12:00 pm – 12:30 pm. Information/Lunch Reservations: Call 713-248-1277 between the hours of 9 am to 10:30 am.

February 20, 2022 Chapter 10. The legion apostolate

To portray the dignity of the apostolate to which the Legion summons its members, and its importance to the Church, one can find no more emphatic words than the following authoritative declarations:

“From the fact of their union with Christ the head, flows the laymen’s right and duty to be apostles. Inserted as they are in the Mystical Body of Christ by baptism and strengthened by the power of the Holy Spirit in confirmation, it is by the Lord himself that they are assigned to the apostolate. If they are consecrated a kingly priesthood and a holy nation (cf 1 Pet 2:4-10), it is in order that they may in all their actions offer spiritual sacrifices and bear witness to Christ all the world over. Charity, which is, as it were, the soul of the whole apostolate, is given to them and nourished in them by the sacraments, the Eucharist above all.” (AA 3)

“Pope Pius XII once stated: ‘The faithful, more precisely the lay faithful, find themselves on the front lines of the Church’s life; for them the Church is the animating principle for human society. Therefore, they, in particular, ought to have an ever-clearer consciousness not only of belonging to the Church, but of being the Church, that is to say, the community of the faithful on earth under the leadership of the Pope, the head of all, and of the bishops in communion with him. These are the Church . . .’ ” (CL 9)

“Mary exercises over the human race a moral influence which we cannot better determine than by comparing it to those physical forces of attraction, affinity and cohesion, which in the order of nature unite together bodies and the parts of which they are composed. . . . We believe we have shown that Mary took part in all the great movements which constitute the life of societies and their real civilization.” (Petitalot)

20 de Febrero Capítulo X. Apostolado Legionario

Para poner de relieve la dignidad del apostolado al que la Legión llama a sus miembros, así como la importancia que este apostolado tiene para la Iglesia, no hallamos palabras más categóricas que las siguientes y firmes declaraciones:

«Los cristianos seglares obtienen el derecho y la obligación del apostolado por su unión con Cristo Cabeza. Ya que, insertos por el bautismo en el Cuerpo místico de Cristo, robustecidos por la Confirmación en la fortaleza del Espíritu Santo, son destinados al apostolado por el mismo Señor. Se consagran como sacerdocio real y gente santa (cf. 1 Pedro 2,4-10) para ofrecer hostias espirituales por medio de todas sus obras, y para dar testimonio de Cristo en todas las partes del mundo. La caridad, que es como el alma de todo apostolado, se comunica y mantiene con los sacramentos, sobre todo de la Eucaristía» (Apostólicam Actuositatem, 3).

«Ya Pío XII decía: "Los fieles, y más precisamente los laicos, se encuentran en la línea más avanzada de la vida de la Iglesia; por ellos la Iglesia es el principio vital de la sociedad humana. Por tanto ellos, ellos especialmente, deben tener conciencia, cada vez más clara, no sólo de pertenecer a la Iglesia, sino de ser la Iglesia, es decir, la comunidad de los fieles sobre la tierra bajo la guía del Jefe común, el Papa, y de los obispos en comunión con él. Ellos son la Iglesia (...)» (Christifideles Laici, 9).

«María ejerce sobre el género humano una influencia moral que no podemos definir mejor que comparándola con esas fuerzas físicas de atracción, afinidad y cohesión, que, en el orden de la naturaleza, unen los cuerpos y sus partes componentes entre sí... Creemos haber demostrado que María ha tenido parte en todas las grandes gestas que constituyen la vida de las sociedades y su verdadera civilización» (Petitalot).

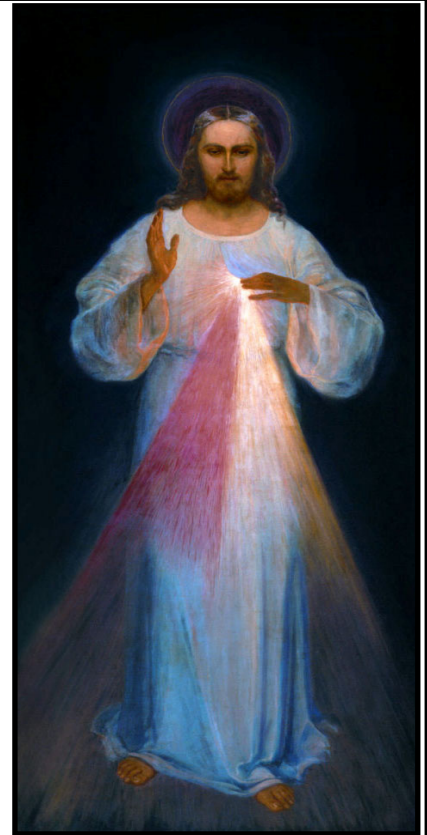
