## Pastor's Notes

*Dear Parishioners,*

May is the month of Mary, the Mother of Jesus. Last Sunday, we concluded our Faith Formation classes for the year by crowning the statue of Mary and praying the Litany of Loreto with our students. On that same day, Pope Francis concluded his weekly address by saying, "In this month of May let us pray the Rosary, asking the Blessed Virgin for the gift of peace."



Throughout his papacy, Pope Francis has frequently invoked Our Lady for her heavenly assistance. For example, throughout the Covid-19 pandemic, he repeatedly called on her to protect people from illness and to heal those suffering from the virus; to shield doctors and nurses from contagion and to inspire researchers; and to comfort those who suffered loss. Last year, at the outbreak of war between Russia and Ukraine, he consecrated those nations to Our Lady and encouraged everyone to pray the rosary for the end of the conflict.

In 2020, Pope Francis offered a reflection on the month of May. He wrote, "It is traditional in this month to pray the Rosary at home within the family. ... For this reason, I want to encourage everyone to rediscover the beauty of praying the Rosary at home in the month of May. This can be done either as a group or individually; you can decide according to your own situations, making the most of both opportunities. The key to doing this is always simplicity, and it is easy also on the internet to find good models of prayers to follow."

As we mark Mother's Day today, let us especially remember Mary, our spiritual mother, and frequently call on her for help. May she be the mother of our families.

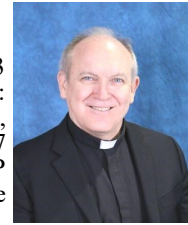
