Pastor's Notes

Dear Parishioners,

This year Pope Francis chose as the theme for "World Mission Sunday": "Hearts on fire, feet on the move." It was inspired by the encounter on Easter Sunday of Jesus with the two disciples on their way to Emmaus (Luke 24:13-35): their hearts burned, their eyes were opened, and their feet set out on the way. In his message for this annual appeal, Pope Francis unpacked these three images as they relate to the Church's missionary activity.

Pope Francis first recalled the details of the meeting of the disciples—discouraged by their master's rejection and death—and their Risen Lord. Jesus took the initiative, approached them and walked alongside them. Turning to us, the pope said: "So let us always be willing to let ourselves be accompanied by the Risen Lord as he explains to us the meaning of the Scriptures. May he make our hearts burn within us; may he enlighten and transform us, so that we can proclaim his mystery of salvation to the world with the power and wisdom that come from his Spirit."

The pope next considered how "their eyes were opened and they recognized him" in the breaking of the bread. Pope Francis reflected on how "every missionary disciple is called to become, like Jesus and in him, through the working of the Holy Spirit, one who breaks the bread and one who is broken bread for the world." He ended this section by quoting Pope Benedict XVI: "An authentically Eucharistic Church is a missionary Church."

In the last part of his reflection, the pope considered the disciples' haste in returning to Jerusalem "to share with others the joy of meeting the Lord. ... One cannot truly encounter the risen Jesus without being set on fire with enthusiasm to tell everyone about him. Therefore, the primary and principal resource of the mission are those persons who have come to know the Risen Christ in the Scriptures and in the Eucharist, who carry his fire in their heart and his light in their gaze."

On this World Mission Sunday, may we deepen our missionary sense of the Church within ourselves and support those who have dedicated their lives to this work.


