# Pastor's Notes

### Dear Parishioners,

Sixteen months ago, Bishop Folda blessed the new site of our church and helped break ground on Phase I of our new facility. For over a year, the construction crew has been busy building our new spiritual home. If you drive by the site you may have noticed all the activity. Unfortunately, you have not been able to see all the work that has been happening inside the building. The various rooms and spaces are taking shape, our dream is indeed becoming a reality. For a glimpse of the progress, you can see a few pictures on the "Building" page of our website.

I have been told that major construction should be completed just after the New Year. Once done, office furniture, kitchen appliances, storage shelving and so much more will need to be installed to make the space functional. And so, the conversation is shifting from designing, planning and construction to preparing for our move. It is an exciting time.

Various subcommittees have begun to meet to discuss and plan how to execute this move. We need to inventory and evaluate what from our church, offices, kitchen, social hall and classrooms will be used in the new building.

We have scheduled a meeting for 7:00 p.m. on Monday, November 27, to discuss the kitchen and social hall. Our task will be to note what we have, determine what will be taken over to the new site and what will be sold. For example, since we are getting new appliances and will not need the three stoves, they will be sold. We will schedule a rummage sale for some time in May or June. (Nothing is being sold now!) We are also open to hear your ideas about the new kitchen and social hall. If you want to be part of the discussion, and to help us count plates, glasses, silverware and everything else in the kitchen, join us on November 27. Sometime in early 2024, we will meet again to discuss how to get everything from here to there.

Again, the meeting on November 27 will focus on the kitchen and social hall. As announced earlier, most of the church patrimony will be incorporated into our new building. Liturgical items and church art which will not be used immediately will be put into storage.

Finally, although a firm date has not yet been set, we hope to be in our new building around Easter. Please continue to pray for the spiritual success of this

transition. It is hard to say "good bye", but as our ancestors did over 150 years ago, we are planting the seeds of the Catholic faith for countless generations to come.

May Mary, the Mother of God, and St. Benedict, our patron, guide us in this process.






