Pastor's Notes

Dear Parishioners

In his monthly column for the January 2024 *New Earth*, Bishop Folda invites the faithful of the Diocese of Fargo to prayerfully consider, write and submit Proposals for the Third Synod of the Diocese of Fargo. As a result of the 2,400 self-assessment surveys, the sixteen listening sessions, and other input, Bishop Folda identified the following three focus areas:

- **I. Encounter:** How can we encounter Christ, especially in the Eucharist, and foster communion with him and each other in the Church?
- **II. Formation:** How are we formed in our identity as missionary disciples so that we are prepared to live, witness and hand on the gift of faith?
- **III. Mission:** As individual believers and Catholic communities, how can we fulfill our mission to proclaim Christ to others in all circumstances and to all people throughout the Diocese of Fargo?

For each area, he also provides discussion questions. However, he intends these to be "conversational starters" and does not expect anyone to answer all of them. Please submit Proposals to Fr. Jasinski, the parish office, or directly to Steve Splonskowski, the Synod Facilitator (he must receive them no later than February 15).

The major agenda item at our January 25th Parish Council meeting will be the drafting Synod Propositions.

At the Synod Assembly, April 11-13, the Synod Delegates will discuss and revise Synod Proposals, and ultimately vote on which ones to recommend to Bishop Folda.


