Pastor's Notes

Dear Parishioners,

The other day I saw a report on the local TV news about students on a field trip. It made me recall some of the fields trips I took when I was in school. In grade school we went to the museum, the zoo and city hall. In high school we visited the state capitol, attended a professional baseball game, and a symphony orchestra concert. However, what I saw on the news the other day was different; it was unlike any field trip I took.

The news report was about students from Shanley High School. Fifteen years ago Shanley High School started the tradition of inviting their students to travel to Washington D.C. to participate in the annual March for Life. Yes, in the middle of winter they make a cross-country trip in support of life. It is better to call it a pilgrimage than a field trip. It is a spiritual journey, an expression of their faith to the sanctity of human life.

This is a distinctive feature of Catholic education: students are formed to express their faith in public. This is what I experienced at the Catholic High School I attended. We never protested against abortion, but we prayed before our sporting events, had Eucharist processions outside, and walked down the street to the local parish church on Holy Days. These experiences and other ways were expressions of our identity as Catholics.

This week we celebrate Catholic Schools Week, a time when students and parents show their gratitude to the benefactors who make Catholic education possible. St. Benedict is a sponsoring parish of the St. John Paul II Catholic Schools. Our parish families who make the sacrifice to send their children to Catholic schools, thank us for supporting the unique opportunities they are given to grow in faith.

May St. Benedict, our patron—who considered each community he established "a school of the Lord's Service"—pray for the flourishing of our Catholic schools.


