### Pastor's Notes

### Dear Parishioners,

The September 2023 issue of *New Earth* featured an article on the "Living our Faith, Building our Future" diocesan capital campaign. In his monthly column of that same issue, Bishop Folda offered his words about this campaign. In my "Pastor's Notes" in our October 8, 2023 parish bulletin, I wrote that we will participate in this campaign in the Fall of 2024. I bring this to your attention, because in the "God's Gift Appeal" video which we will watch this weekend, Bishop Folda talks about these initiatives. As you will hear, he states that about 25% of the parishes in the Diocese of Fargo participated in the diocesan capital campaign last Fall. Another 33% will participate this Spring. As I said above, we will be part of the last group next Fall.

In the video, Bishop Folda explains the difference between the "God's Gift Appeal" and the "Living our Faith, Building our Future" capital campaign. "God's Gift" is the annual appeal supporting our bishop and his staff as they serve parishes throughout the Diocese of Fargo. On the other hand, pledges to the diocesan capital campaign support the special projects identified by Bishop Folda in the "Living our Faith, Building our Future" campaign (for more information, visit <a href="https://www.fargodiocese.org/lof">www.fargodiocese.org/lof</a>).

The same dynamic is at play here at St. Benedict Parish. Your weekly donations support our daily operations. A year ago, we concluded our "Embracing our Tradition" capital campaign. It provided the initial funding of our building project. Next Fall we will begin a capital campaign to pay down the loan we took to cover the remainder of the construction costs.

I conclude by quoting Bishop Folda's final words in this year's God Gift Appeal video: "Please prayerfully consider a gift in accordance with Our Lord's generosity to you." Thank you for your ongoing support of our bishop, our diocese and of our parish.


