Pastor's Notes

Dear Parishioners,

As we prepare to move to our new location, I have been reflecting on the heritage of St. Benedict Parish. Last week I recalled the various structures which served as churches throughout our history. Since the current building is over 110 years old, no-one living today has memories of the church built in 1888. As I piece things together, some of the religious art in the current church must have come from the former church.

The First Reading at Mass this weekend is from the Book of Exodus. In it we hear God giving Moses the Ten Commandments. God loved his people so much that he gave them a sure and solid moral code to guide their actions. Throughout history, the Ten Commandments have been diligently handed down from parents to their children.

The Blessed Virgin Mary learned the tenets of the Jewish faith from her mother, St. Anne. Our statue of St. Anne and Mary shows them holding a scroll which has the Roman numerals "I" (one) through "X" (ten). St. Anne taught Mary the Ten Commandments. The stained glass window of St. Anne and Mary shows St. Anne pointing to the scroll, as if to say, "Learn the Commandments and live them."

In preparation for its move to our new site, the statue of St. Anne teaching Mary is being repaired and renovated. Once in our new home, it will remind us of the generations who taught the Ten Commandments, learned them, and lived by them.

A historical note: the statue of St. Anne is the one crowned by Alex Richard in thanksgiving to her for saving his life. For over 135 years, this statue has been a reminder of her powerful intercession. This is our legacy.

May St. Anne and the Mary, the Mother of Jesus, pray for us.
