

Dear Parishioners,

Today we pause to thank our mothers for the gifts of life, nurturing and tenderness. The bond between a mother and her child is unique among all human relationships. It is the foundation of a child's flourishing. This Mother's Day we also remember mothers who are no longer with us, those who have died. May the Lord grant them eternal peace.



As he has done on many occasions, this past
Wednesday Pope Francis again encouraged us to pray the rosary to
Our Mother, Mary. In his message, Pope Francis entrusted to her people
around the world suffering from wars and conflicts. He said, "I invite
everyone to invoke Mary's intercession, so that the Lord may grant peace
to the whole world, especially to the dear and martyred Ukraine, and
Palestine, Israel, and Myanmar." He concluded his remarks by insisting, "I
urge everyone to value the prayer of the Holy Rosary in this month of May."

Pope Francis' devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary is obvious. On the day after his election to the papacy, he went to the Basilica of St. Mary Major and prayed before the ancient icon of "Salus Populi Romani" ("Salvation of the Roman People"). Before each of his foreign trips (to date he has made over 100 of them!), he goes to this same Basilica to pray to Our Mother, and, on his return, returns there to thank her. On December 12, 2023, he revealed that he will break with the tradition of recent popes and has planned to be buried in this Basilica dedicated to Mary (six other popes have been buried there, the most recent in 1605.)

May, the Mary of Jesus, pray for and watch over all our mothers.






