Dear Parishioners,

One month after we moved out of the St. Joseph religious education building, a construction company began renting it. At the same time, items which we will incorporate into our future church were crated and put into storage. At the end of May, we had our estate sale. Next Saturday at 10:00 a.m., Fr. Bernier's skull will be interred in St. Benedict Cemetery.

Unfortunately, no one purchased the old priest house. So, it is being prepared to be demolished along with the church (more information will be published next week). The removal of these building will completely change the landscape of St. Benedict Cemetery.

More significant than these "external" changes, are changes to staff. This past week we said "Good bye" to Linda Skjerseth, who has served as Director of Religious Education for the past 12 years. At the end of August, Maria Saville, who has been an indispensable employee the last 16 years, will move on. Pray that qualified and dedicated people apply for these job openings.


