#### **Jubilee Opening Mass**

Sunday, December 29, 10:00 a.m. Cathedral of St. Mary, Fargo.

The theme of the Jubilee Year 2025 is "Pilgrims of Hope."



The Pope has asked that the local bishop of every cathedral around the world celebrate Mass on Dec. 29 to mark the opening of the Jubilee Year.

#### PASTOR'S NOTES

#### Dear Parishioners.

The Church has observed Jubilee Years on a regular basis since 1300. It originates from the Jewish practice of marking a Jubilee every 50 years. At first, the pope proposed that the Catholic Church celebrate Jubilee Years every 100 years. We now celebrate them every 25 years. (There are "Extraordinary Jubilees" which occur at other times.) The last "Ordinary Jubilee" was the Great Jubilee of the Year 2000. And so, the year 2025 will be a Jubilee Year.

The booklet written for the 125<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of St. Benedict Parish has a section entitled "Mission Cross with Corpus." It contains the following text: "This crucifix was purchased by Father Lalande with donations received after a parish mission given at the church in 1925." It goes on to describe where this cross was displayed in the old church. As I explained last week, Fr. Lalande was pastor of St. Benedict 1904–1935, and he appears to be the one responsible for acquiring a relic of St. Anne for St. Benedict Parish.

This brief account about the "Mission Cross" notes that the crucifix was the result of a parish mission. No other information has been found in the parish archives about the mission (the exact dates it was held, the name of the priest who preached, etc.). However, it is clear that the mission occurred in 1925, a Jubilee Year. When Bishop Folda heard that we had a crucifix from a Jubilee Year, he was interested in it. It was not immediately clear to me why.

On Christmas Eve, Pope Francis will open the Holy Door of St. Peter's Basilica, beginning the Jubilee of the Year 2025. Next Sunday, December 29<sup>th</sup>, Bishop Folda will begin the local observance of the Jubilee in the Diocese of Fargo. The Rite of the Opening of the Jubilee Year indicates that a special cross be designated the Jubilee Year Cross. It says: "It is placed near the altar in the sanctuary (of the cathedral) where it remains for the entire Jubilee Year for the veneration of the faithful." Bishop Folda has chosen the St. Benedict's "Mission Cross" to be *the* Jubilee Cross for the Diocese of Fargo.

The restoration of our crucifix was only recently finished. We never had the opportunity to display it here. So, ironically, the only way for us to see our newly restored crucifix during the next year is to visit St. Mary's Cathedral. So, plan on visiting the Cathedral during the upcoming Jubilee Year, praying before our cross, and receiving the Jubilee Year indulgence (which I will explain next week).

May you and your loved ones have a very blessed Christmas.


