Pastor's Notes

Dear Parishioners,

Last week I began to share the Message of Pope Francis for the Thirty-Third observation of the World Day of the Sick, which occurs on February 11, this upcoming Tuesday.

The theme he chose is, "Hope does not disappoint, but strengthens us in times of trial." In reflecting on these words, he said, "These are comforting words, but they can also prove perplexing, especially for those who are suffering. How can we be strong, for example, when our bodies are prey to severe, debilitating illnesses that require costly treatment that we may not be able to afford? How can we show strength when, in addition to our own sufferings, we see those of our loved ones who support us yet feel powerless to help us? In these situations, we sense our need for a strength greater than our own. We realize that we need God's help, his grace, his Providence, and the strength that is the gift of his Spirit." The Pope proposes that God is close to the sick in three ways: "encounter", "gift" and "sharing".

Last week, we were reminded that Jesus shares in our suffering. The Pope concludes, "Sickness, then, becomes an occasion for a transformative encounter, the discovery of a solid rock to which we can hold fast amid the tempests of life, an experience that, even at great cost, makes us all the stronger because it teaches us that we are not alone. Suffering always brings with it a mysterious promise of salvation"

Here, Pope Francis shifts to the second way God is close to the sick and suffering: "gift". "More than anything else," he says, "suffering makes us aware that hope comes from the Lord. It is thus, first and foremost, a gift to be received and cultivated, by remaining faithful to the faithfulness of God." The "great hope" of our faith is Jesus' Death and Resurrection, and his promise of eternal life. By recognizing his presence, especially in the Eucharist, "[we] sense that 'greater reality' which, by drawing near to us, restores our courage and confidence."

This Tuesday, the World Day of the Sick, I invite everyone to pray for the sick and elderly of St. Benedict Parish, that their faith and hope in Jesus may increase. May Mary, who stood by Jesus in his suffering, accompany those who suffer on their way to heaven.


