### Pastor's Notes

### Dear Parishioners,

The God's Gift Campaign is the annual appeal by our bishop to support him and the work of the Diocese of Fargo. This year, Bishop Folda chose the theme "Journey with Hope," intentionally echoing Pope Francis' theme for the Jubilee Year, "Pilgrims of Hope." This theme summarizes his words to us this past year.

Every month Bishop Folda publishes a column in the *New Earth* in which he reflects with us on our experience of being Catholic in the Diocese of Fargo. This past year, he repeatedly reflected on the role of the Eucharistic in our spiritual lives; he shared with us his experience of participating in the National Eucharistic Congress; he invited us to pray for the Diocesan Synod, be part of its preparation, and offered some initial insights into it fruits; he wrote about the Jubilee Year; he spoke about other issues, such as education, rural life and voting; and, in January, he encouraged us to engage with the "Walking with One" initiative. In all these articles, he constantly called us to live and witness to the Gospel. He is a bishop who wants the Church to be vibrant and her members to have the same missionary attitude of the first disciples of Jesus.

Bishop Folda realizes that he cannot accomplish this work alone. We journey together with our bishop as faithful pilgrims. He counts on us to do our part to live the Gospel and support him as our leader. While our financial support is necessary, so is our spiritual support. Please remember Bishop Folda often in your prayers. He often says that he is praying for us. His most recent column in February was simply entitled "Thank you!" In it he expressed his gratitude to us for supporting his vision. Together, we journey with hope.

May Mary, conceived without Original Sin, pray for the Diocese of Fargo and Bishop Folda.
