#### Pastor's Notes

### Dear Parishioners,

The election of a pope is an extraordinary event in the life of the Church. The process highlights the dual nature of the Church: it is a divine institution entrusted to human persons.

The process of choosing a pope has varied throughout history. For a time in the early Church, the pope named his successor. During a different period in time, the clergy of the Diocese of Rome elected the next pope. There were also times when emperors and kings had an active role in naming the Bishop of Rome. Currently, Cardinals who are less than 80 years old gather to elect a new pope.

Since the death of Pope Francis, the Cardinals from around the world have gathered in Rome, to pray for Pope Francis and discuss priorities for the Church. On Wednesday, they will celebrate Mass and be led to the Sistine Chapel, where voting will take place. By the end of the week, we may hear the Latin phrase, "Habmus papam" ("We have a pope")!

Bishop Folda asked every pastor to celebrate a Mass for the conclave. The 8:30 a.m. Mass at St. Benedict on Tuesday morning, May 6th, with be for "The Election of a Pope." Whether you are able to attend this Mass or not, please pray for our next pope and the Cardinals who will elect him. You may use the prayer below or other prayers.
