Pastor's Notes



Dear Parishioners,

Today, Mother's Day, we pause to thank our mothers for the gift of life, and their care, nurturing and tenderness. Pope Francis had a profound love of Mary, the Mother of God. Before becoming pope, he promoted the devotion to Mary, Undoer of Knots. Throughout his papacy he encouraged the recitation of the rosary and the "Sub tuum praesidium" (an ancient prayer to Our Lady). Before and after travels, he visited the Basilica dedicated to Mary in Rome. During Covid he brought the icon of Mary from the St. Mary's Basilica to the Vatican, to pray for an end to the pandemic.

On September 3, 2018, during a reflection of the Motherhood of the Church, Pope Francis turned to the example of Mary: "In her motherhood, the Church has the Virgin Mary as a model, the most beautiful and most lofty model that there could be. ... The motherhood of Mary is surely unique, singular, and was brought about in the fullness of time, when the Virgin gave birth to the Son of God, conceived through the power of the Holy Spirit. However, the motherhood of the Church is established in precise continuity with that of Mary, as her continuation in history. ... We understand, then, how the relationship which unites Mary and the Church is so deep: by looking at Mary, we discover the most beautiful and most tender face of the Church; and by looking at the Church, we recognize the sublime features of Mary. We Christians are not orphans, we have a mama, we have a mother, and this is great! We are not orphans! The Church is mother, Mary is mother."

It was not surprising to learn that Pope Francis requested to be buried in St. Mary's Basilica in Rome, rather than at St. Peter's Basilica. It was a final gesture of love to Mary, his mother.

In May, a month dedicated to Mary, let us turn frequently to Mary, our mother.
