#### Pastor's Notes

#### Dear Parishioners,

Today we celebrate a bitter-sweet moment in the life of the Church. On this day, Jesus ascended into heaven. At the Last Supper, Jesus was very clear that he was leaving his disciples. He said, "Because I have said these things to you, sorrow has filled your hearts. Nevertheless, I tell you the truth: it is to your advantage that I go away, for if I do not go away, the Counselor will not come to you; but if I go, I will send him to you."

Next weekend, we will celebrate the end of the Easter season with the celebration of the Solemnity of Pentecost. This day fulfills the promise Jesus made at the Last Supper, and is the completion of the Paschal Mystery. Pray for the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. May our hearts be open to the presence of the Holy Spirit in our lives, our families, and our parish.

At the end of this week, there will be a special outpouring of the Holy Spirit on the Diocese of Fargo: Bishop Folda will ordain six men. Five men will be ordained deacons and one will be ordained a priest. God willing, a year from now the five deacons will be ordained priests. Continue to pray for vocations to the priesthood. Especially pray for the young men of St. Benedict Parish that God is inviting to be priests. May the Holy Spirit open their hearts to this special calling.

#### Fargo Diocese - Corpus Christi Camino Jubilee Pilgrimage

Come join us for a 4-day walking pilgrimage along the North Country Trail. We begin in Dazey, ND on the Solemnity of *Corpus Christi*, June 22, and end at Maryvale, outside of Valley City, on June 25.

Pilgrims will camp overnight on the parish grounds before beginning the Camino the next morning. The Camino will follow the North Country Scenic Trail all the way to Maryvale. All meals provided. Not included are camping equipment, tents, etc. There will be transportation of camping equipment to the midway point, Mel Reiman Campground, and again to Maryvale. Total: 23 miles. Must be at least 12 years old. All minors must be accompanied by an adult. The cost is \$95 per adult, ages 12-17 are \$75 per person.
