Man of the Shroud Traveling Exhibit

The "Man of the Shroud Traveling Exhibit" is finally coming to the Diocese of Fargo! It features an exact replica of the burial cloth of Christ, known as the Shroud of Turin. The exhibit gives the history of this holy cloth and its fascinating details. It will be at

St. Mary's Cathedral, Fargo, from August 23rd to 31st.

The Shroud of Turin is a linen cloth that bears a faint image of the front and back of a man who died by crucifixion. It has been venerated for centuries as the actual burial shroud used to wrap the body of Jesus in after his crucifixion, and upon which Jesus' bodily image was miraculously imprinted. There have been countess studies through the ages that cannot scientifically explain the image. The original cloth is in Turin, Italy, and is currently not on public display.

There will be special presentations on the Shroud of Turin by expert, Jim Bertrand, on Sunday, August 24, and again on Monday, August 25. Each starts at 7:00 p.m. in the Cathedral. The presentation on Monday will be live streamed through the Diocese of Fargo Youtube channel
