Man of the Shroud Traveling Exhibit

The "Man of the Shroud Traveling Exhibit" is finally coming to the Diocese of Fargo! It features an exact replica of the burial cloth of Christ, known as the Shroud of Turin. The exhibit gives the history of this holy cloth and its fascinating details. It will be at

**St. Mary's Cathedral, Fargo,
from August 23rd to 31st.**

The Shroud of Turin is a linen cloth that bears a faint image of the front and back of a man who died by crucifixion. It has been venerated for centuries as the actual burial shroud used to wrap the body of Jesus in after his crucifixion, and upon which Jesus' bodily image was miraculously imprinted. There have been countless studies through the ages that cannot scientifically explain the image. The original cloth is in Turin, Italy, and is currently not on public display.

There will be special presentations on the Shroud of Turin by expert, Jim Bertrand, on Sunday, August 24, and again on Monday, August 25. Each starts at 7:00 p.m. in the Cathedral. The presentation on Monday will be live streamed through the Diocese of Fargo Youtube channel
(www.youtube.com/@dioceseoffargo4555).

Pastor's Notes

Dear Parishioners,

Although it had been a long-standing Feast Day in the Church, the dogma of the Assumption was declared only recently. On November 1, 1950, in the apostolic constitution "Munificentissimus Deus", Pope Pius XII solemnly proclaimed: "We pronounce, declare and define it to be a divinely revealed dogma: that the Immaculate Mother of God, the ever-Virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory."

Seventy-five years ago, the world was recovering from the brutality of two world wars and was witnessing the growing threat of Communism. Pope Pius XII encouraged Marian devotion as a way to transform humanity. He knew that society would change only if people's hearts changed. In proclaiming the dogma of Mary's Assumption, he hoped that people would remember that their final goal is heaven and desire the salvation of others. This is what the world needed then, and still needs today!

As Pope Pius XII desired a greater awareness of the transforming effects of Jesus' Passion, Death and Resurrection, may we promote true human welfare by keeping our eyes fixed on Mary in heaven. Her unique participation in the Paschal Mystery should instill hope in us. May the intercession of our heavenly Queen bring peace to our hearts and to the world.
