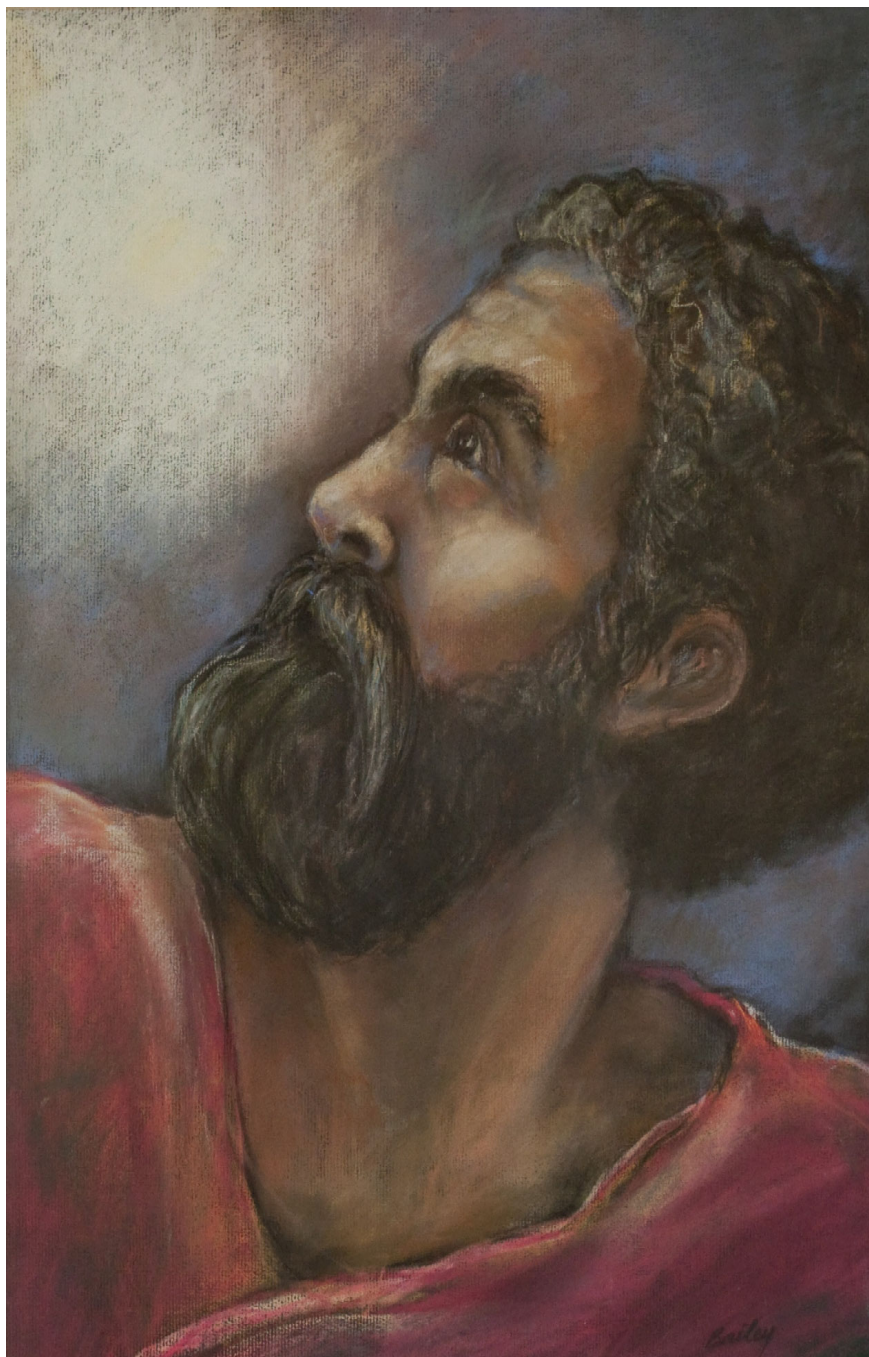

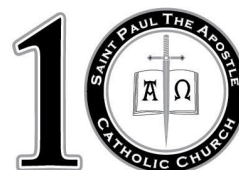

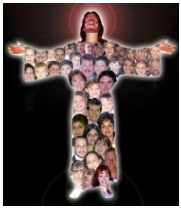

The Blessed Sacrament is exposed for Eucharistic Adoration every Wednesday from 3:00 PM to 6:30 PM. The Holy Mass is celebrated at 7:00 PM.
