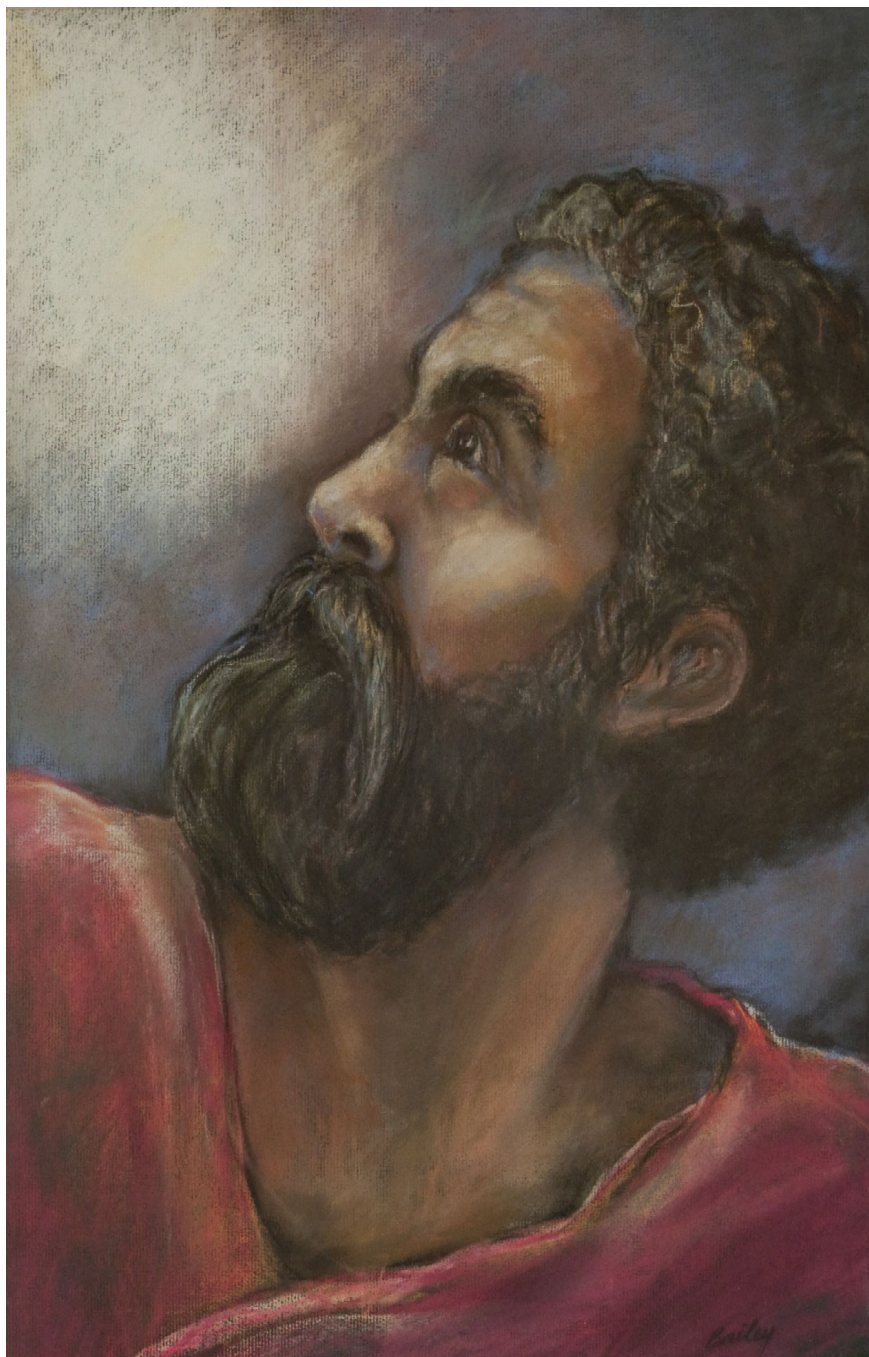

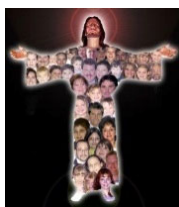
BLESSING OF ANIMALS

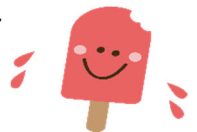

Junipero Serra Canonization

Pope Francis will canonize Blessed Junipero Serra on September 23, 2015, at the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington, D.C.
