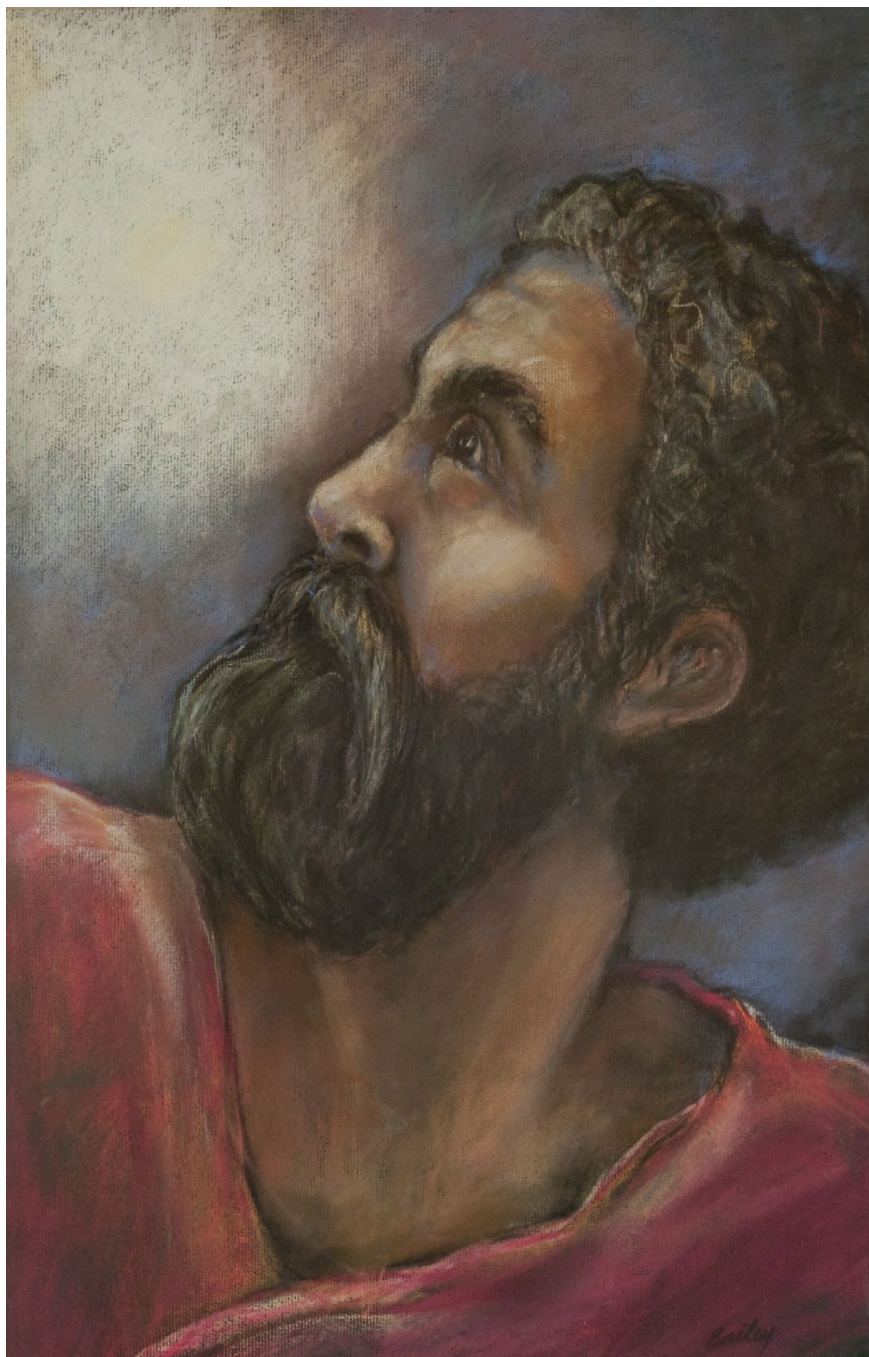

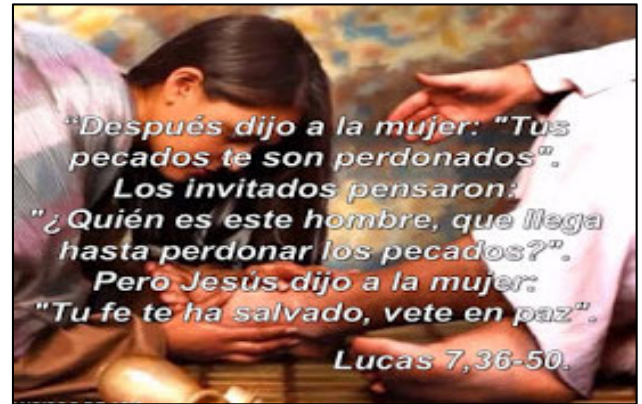

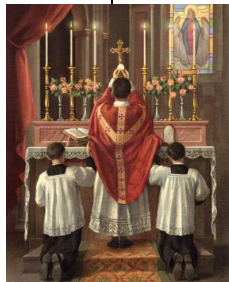
TRAINING FOR MASS PLANNERS

WHY DO CATHOLICS OFFER MASSES FOR THOSE WHO HAVE DIED? (continued)

All pastors are required to offer one Mass on Sunday for the intentions of the living and deceased parishioners of a parish. The pastor does not receive anything for it: it is his gift to his people, who now know in turn that all their intentions are rolled up into this one "super-intention."

The Mass offering (donation) is meant to help provide for the expenses related to the celebration of the Mass. After all, the Mass requires books, candles, and altar linens. And what about the church building the Mass is being said in? Buildings are pretty darned expensive. Another "expense" related to the celebration of the Mass is the expense of having a priest. Priests have to eat. They need a roof over their head. They need to be trained, and ideally they stay up to date in that training. The Mass offering, therefore, is also meant to help the priest to live. The offering amount is typically very low, such that it is often merely a symbolic reference to the support required to be able to celebrate the Mass in the first place. In the Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston, the Mass intention offering is \$5. To offer a Mass for a deceased loved one or for a particular intention at St Paul, please come to or call the Welcome Center Monday through Friday (8 AM -4 PM).

Todos los pastores están obligados a ofrecer una Misa el domingo por las intenciones de los feligreses vivos y difuntos de la parroquia. El pastor no recibe nada para él: es su regalo a su pueblo, que a su vez sabemos que sus intenciones se ruedan para arriba en un "Super-intencion.")

La ofrenda para la Misa (la donación) está destinado a ayudar a proveer para los gastos relacionados con la celebración de la Misa. Después de todo, la Misa requiere libros y velas litúrgicas. Y ¿qué pasa con el edificio de la Misa la iglesia se dice en? Los edificios son muy caros. Otro "gasto" relacionado con la celebración de la Misa es el gasto de tener un sacerdote. Sacerdotes tienen que comer. Necesitan un techo sobre su cabeza. Necesitan ser entrenados, e idealmente continúan estudiar y aprender. La ofrenda para la Misa, por lo tanto, también está destinado a ayudar al sacerdote a vivir. La cantidad de la ofrenda es muy baja, tal que a menudo es simplemente una referencia simbólica a la ayuda necesaria para poder celebrar la Misa en primer lugar. En la Arquidiócesis de Galveston-Houston, la ofrenda para una intención de la Misa es de \$5. 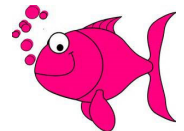
