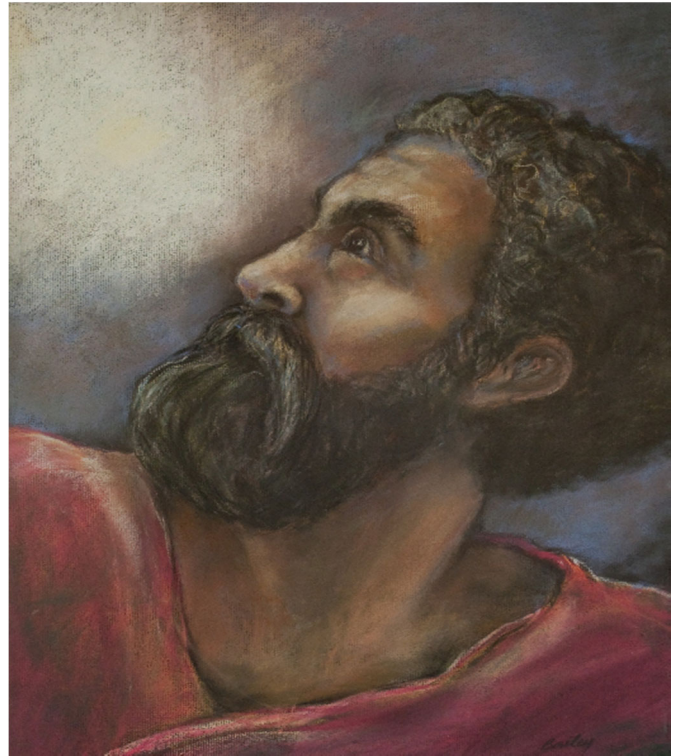

Child Labor/Trafficking for Cocoa

Recently one of our Vincentians brought an article to our conference meeting, describing the use of child labor in the cocoa farming in Africa. Astonishingly enough, many of our household brand names acknowledged the use of child labor in their chocolate supply chains, **Hershey** (the top producer of chocolate in the US), **Nestle**, **Godiva** and **Mars**. **Starbucks** website says it plans to be child-labor-free by 2020. Economics is the driver behind these practices. "Lord make us responsive to the Christian call to seek and find the forgotten, the suffering or the deprived so that we may bring them your love." Prayer of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul Brother and Sister Vincentians. Human trafficking is modern day slavery. As a Voice of the Poor, let us speak out against this evil and call for justice for victims.

An article from the Washington Post, "Cocoa's child laborers" (June 5, 2019) can help you better understand the dire needs of these children. It details the lives of children as young as 10 working in cocoa farms for years at a time without seeing family or going to school. The article also explains how major companies have known for many years that the chocolate they purchase comes from child labor/trafficking. The article can be found at the link below:

Several human rights organizations engage in ethical sourcing of materials. Organic and Fair Trade chocolate is almost always ethically sourced. Cocoa from outside West Africa is almost always ethically grown. Companies pride themselves on bean "Bean to Bar" for ethical and culinary reasons. Reading the labels will also tell the source of the chocolate. More on the story of these ethical chocolate companies can be found on their product packaging and on their websites.

What can we do? Look for these images on packaging to help identify ethical companies when purchasing chocolate products.

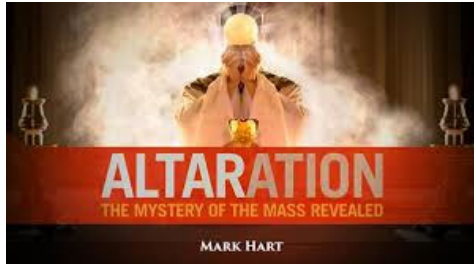

Mass Etiquette: 20 Things To Do And Not To Do In Mass (continued)

15. **No bulletin reading during Mass.** Imagine if you've invited a guest to your house and before dinner (or during), they decide to read a magazine instead of talking to you. That is what is happening in God's house when you read the bulletin.
16. **Respect boundaries others may have.** You might want to hold hands to pray yet others may not. They might be sick and not want to shake during the sign of peace. These are all OK. Do not make any unnecessary judgment because they worship differently. (Read more here: www.ewtn.com/library/Liturgy/zlitur10.htm)
17. **Do not receive from the chalice if you are sick.** This is an act of charity, and it is not necessary to receive from the chalice in order to receive the entirety of Jesus' Body, Blood, and Soul, and Divinity.
18. **Do not leave early.** We should stay to the end of the recession and the hymn that accompanies it, if there is one. While there are certainly exceptions to this guideline, most who leave early don't need to and ought not to.
19. **Pray after Mass, if you feel called to do so.** It is a good custom, though not required, to offer a prayer of thanksgiving after Mass is over.
20. **Leave quietly.** We encourage you to visit with others, but only after you are outside of the main sanctuary of the church, so you don't disturb others who want to stay and pray. So please leave quietly and visit afterward in the outdoor narthex.
