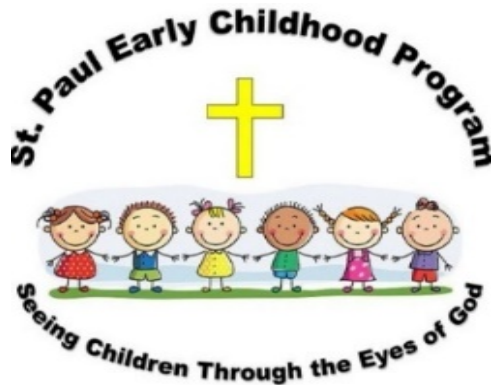

If you would like to go deeper, answer the questions below after reading the Gospel.

Read LUKE 3:39-45

On this the last Sunday before Christmas, our Gospel reading prepares us to witness Christ's birth by showing us how Jesus was recognized as Israel's long-awaited Messiah even before his birth. The Gospel turns our attention from the ministry of John the Baptist to the events that preceded John the Baptist's birth. The story of John the Baptist and his parents, Elizabeth and Zechariah, are reported only in Luke's Gospel. Luke pairs the birth of John the Baptist and Jesus, establishing John's early connection to the Messiah. In Luke's Gospel the Holy Spirit helps reveal Jesus' identity as God to those who believe. Elizabeth is filled with the Holy Spirit and sings Mary's praise because she bears the Lord. We sing these words of praise to Mary in the Hail Mary. Even John the Baptist, the unborn child in Elizabeth's womb, is said to recognize the presence of the Lord and leaps for joy.

It is appropriate in this season of Advent that we consider the role of Mary in God's plan of salvation. Elizabeth describes Mary as the first disciple, as the one who believed that God's word to her would be fulfilled. Mary's faith enabled her to recognize the work of God in her people's history and in her own life. Her openness to God allowed God to work through her so that salvation might come to everyone. Because of this, Mary is a model and symbol of the Church. May we be like Mary, open and cooperative in God's plan for salvation.

Lee LUCAS 3: 39-45

En este último domingo antes de Navidad, nuestra lectura del Evangelio nos prepara para presenciar el nacimiento de Cristo mostrándonos cómo Jesús fue reconocido como el tan esperado Mesías de Israel incluso antes de su nacimiento. El Evangelio dirige nuestra atención del ministerio de Juan el Bautista a los eventos que precedieron al nacimiento de Juan el Bautista. La historia de Juan el Bautista y sus padres, Elizabeth y Zacarías, se informa solo en el Evangelio de Lucas. Lucas empareja el nacimiento de Juan el Bautista y Jesús, estableciendo la conexión temprana de Juan con el Mesías. En el Evangelio de Lucas, el Espíritu Santo ayuda a revelar la identidad de Jesús como Dios a los que creen. Elizabeth está llena del Espíritu Santo y canta la alabanza de María porque lleva al Señor. Cantamos estas palabras de alabanza a María en el Ave María. Incluso se dice que Juan el Bautista, el niño nonato en el vientre de Isabel, reconoce la presencia del Señor y salta de alegría. Es apropiado en esta temporada de Adviento que consideramos el papel de María en el plan de salvación de Dios. Elizabeth describe a María como la primera discípula, como la que creía que la palabra de Dios para ella se cumpliría. La fe de María le permitió reconocer la obra de Dios en la historia de su pueblo y en su propia vida. Su apertura a Dios permitió que Dios trabajara a través de ella para que la salvación pudiera llegar a todos. Debido a esto, María es un modelo y símbolo de la Iglesia. Que seamos como María, abiertos y cooperativos en el plan de salvación de Dios.



In the encounter between Mary and Elizabeth described in today's Gospel, we learn that other people can help us recognize God's presence and action in our lives. Mary traveled to see Elizabeth because Elizabeth's pregnancy was a sign that everything the angel told Mary would truly happen. Elizabeth recognized Mary as the mother of her Lord because her unborn child, John the Baptist, leapt at the sound of Mary's greeting. Elizabeth and Mary rejoiced together at the wonderful things God was doing in their lives. We too are blessed when we have people who help us recognize God's action in our lives. We pray that our family can be this for one another.

En el encuentro entre María y Isabel descrito en el Evangelio de hoy, aprendemos que otras personas pueden ayudarnos a reconocer la presencia y acción de Dios en nuestras vidas. Mary viajó a ver a Elizabeth porque el embarazo de Elizabeth era una señal de que todo lo que el ángel le dijo a Mary realmente sucedería. Elizabeth reconoció a María como la madre de su Señor porque su hijo nonato, Juan el Bautista, saltó al sonido del saludo de María. Elizabeth y Mary se regocijaron juntas por las cosas maravillosas que Dios estaba haciendo en sus vidas. Nosotros también somos bendecidos cuando tenemos personas que nos ayudan a reconocer la acción de Dios en nuestras vidas. Oramos para que nuestra familia pueda ser esto el uno para el otro.
