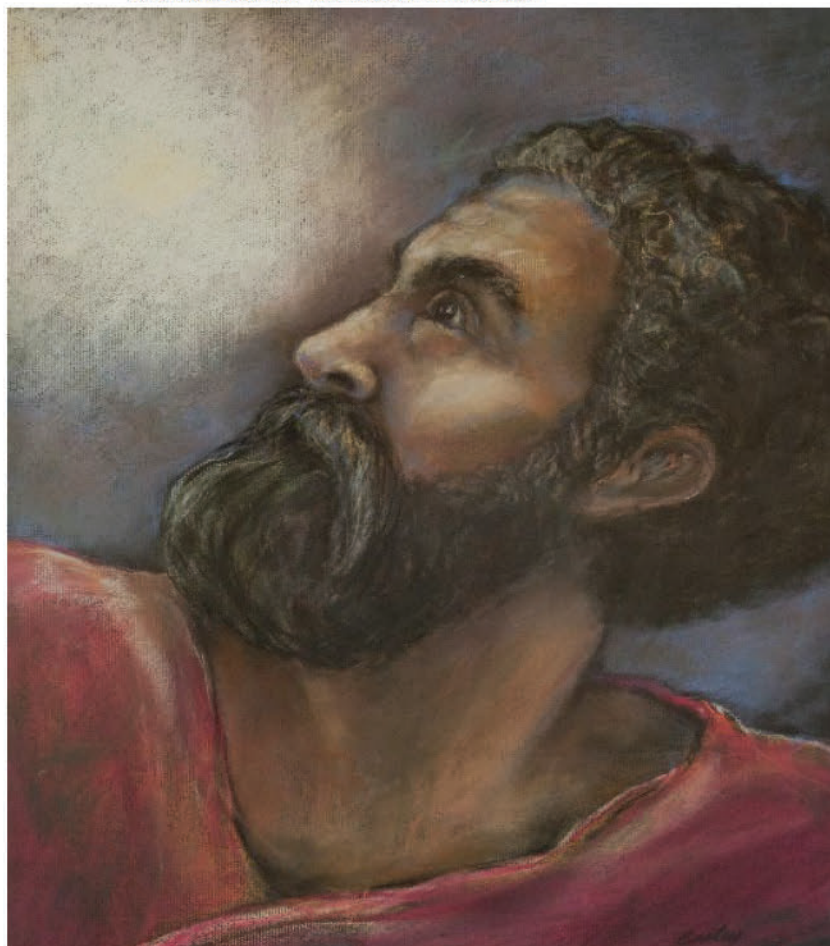

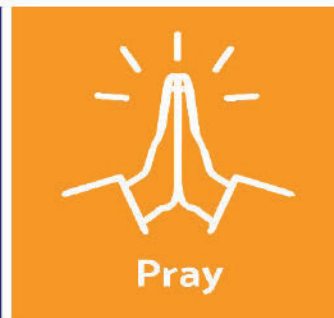
PASTORAL COUNCIL

Summer Daycare 2022**

**Registration for Summer Enrichment & Summer
Daycare is officially open!!!**



Summer Enrichment is a 6-week program beginning June 7th and running through July 14th. The weeks are separated into themes: the first two

weeks we will explore Space; the second two weeks we will discover Dinosaurs; and the third two weeks we will visit the Circus. You may choose to enroll your child in any combination of weeks that you wish. For example, you may want your child to just learn about the circus, or discover dinosaurs, or only participate in one week within each theme. You may also want to enroll them for all six weeks. Any choice of weeks can be accommodated but there is a limit on how many can enroll each week, so please get your registration forms in as soon as you can.



This program is open to children from 1 year (must be walking) to 7 years old. Each week costs \$85 and includes registration,

supply, and tuition fees. Hours are from 9:30 am – 1:30 pm, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday each week during the 6-week period. An updated immunization form is required for each student in order to enroll in all summer programs and must be turned in with the registration form.

Summer Daycare is available from 8 am – 3 pm Monday through Friday, in the same options as



offered during the school year. Many families have both parents who work and need this service throughout the summer. All children who register for summer daycare will be able to experience the enrichment program at no additional cost. There is a one-time \$50 registration and supply fee for summer daycare, but the monthly tuition will remain the same as during the school year. Summer daycare runs from June 6th through August 5th. Fall classes will begin August 22nd. Registration for fall will open on April 1st.

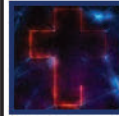

If you would like to go deeper, answer the questions below after reading the Gospel.

Matthew 17:1-9

For the second Sunday of Lent, we move from Jesus' retreat to the desert to his Transfiguration. Each year on the first Sunday of Lent, our Gospel tells the story of Jesus' temptation in the desert. On the second Sunday of Lent each year, we hear the story of Jesus' Transfiguration.

The story of Jesus' Transfiguration is told in the three Synoptic Gospels: Matthew, Mark, and Luke. In each of those Gospels, the Transfiguration follows Jesus' first prediction of his death and his teaching about the costs of discipleship. Jesus' Transfiguration is a promise of Jesus' glory, his Resurrection.

On a mountain in today's reading, a voice affirms that Jesus is God's Son in words reminiscent of the voice at Jesus' baptism. In addition, the appearance of Moses and Elijah on the mountain connects this story with God's relationship to the people of Israel. Moses and Elijah represent the Law and the Prophets, respectively. Together with Jesus, they represent God's complete Word. The Transfiguration occurs in the presence of just three of Jesus' disciples: Peter, James, and John. In Matthew's Gospel, those disciples are among the first whom Jesus calls. The three men are identified as an "inner circle" among Jesus' disciples when Jesus asks them to accompany him to the Garden of Gethsemane just before his arrest.

Mateo 17:1-9

Para el segundo domingo de Cuaresma, nos trasladamos del retiro de Jesús al desierto a su Transfiguración. Cada año, el primer domingo de Cuaresma, nuestro Evangelio cuenta la historia de la tentación de Jesús en el desierto. El segundo domingo de Cuaresma de cada año, escuchamos la historia de la Transfiguración de Jesús.

La historia de la Transfiguración de Jesús se cuenta en los tres Evangelios sinópticos: Mateo, Marcos y Lucas. En cada uno de esos Evangelios, la Transfiguración sigue la primera predicción de Jesús de su muerte y su enseñanza sobre los costos del discipulado. La Transfiguración de Jesús es una promesa de la gloria de Jesús, su Resurrección.

En una montaña en la lectura de hoy, una voz afirma que Jesús es el Hijo de Dios en palabras que recuerdan la voz en el bautismo de Jesús. Además, la aparición de Moisés y Elías en la montaña conecta esta historia con la relación de Dios con el pueblo de Israel. Moisés y Elijah representan la Ley y los Profetas, respectivamente. Junto con Jesús, representan la Palabra completa de Dios.

La Transfiguración ocurre en presencia de solo tres de los discípulos de Jesús: Pedro, Santiago y Juan. En el Evangelio de Mateo, esos discípulos están entre los primeros a quienes Jesús llama. Los tres hombres son identificados como un "círculo interno" entre los discípulos de Jesús cuando Jesús les pide que lo acompañen al Jardín de Getsemaní justo antes de su arresto.

SVDP WEEKLY BULLETIN ANNOUNCEMENT

Lent is a call not just to “give up something” but more important to “give something for the poor.” Wherever you live in the parish, there are poor families within walking distance of your home. When in need, they ring the rectory bell. They are, in effect, ringing your doorbell.

The Society of St. Vincent de Paul is continuing to partner with the Houston Food Bank for biweekly Fresh Food Fairs in the church parking lot. A large number of volunteers are needed to support the success of the fair and our neighbors in need.

So, what do Food Fair Volunteers do?

Direct Traffic: Safely direct cars of our visiting neighbors through the staging line and then through the loading line where food is placed in vehicle trunks or truck beds at several stops.

Intake (bilingual preferred): Hand out and collect short forms, required by the Houston Food Bank, from visiting neighbors in need. When collecting the forms, intake volunteers quickly review the information provided to ensure the most important fields are filled in.

Package Food: The food delivered via Houston Food Bank trucks is typically packed in large compartments and boxes or crates and needs to be parceled and packed into bags for distribution to families.

Load Food: Load pre-packed bags of food, milk jugs, etc. into the trunks or truck beds of neighbors.

Have Fun! Volunteers enjoy great fellowship and fun while serving our brothers and sisters in Christ.

Volunteers must be 14 years or older and if under 18, must be accompanied by an adult who is Safe Haven trained. Please visit the website provided below for a link to the training.
