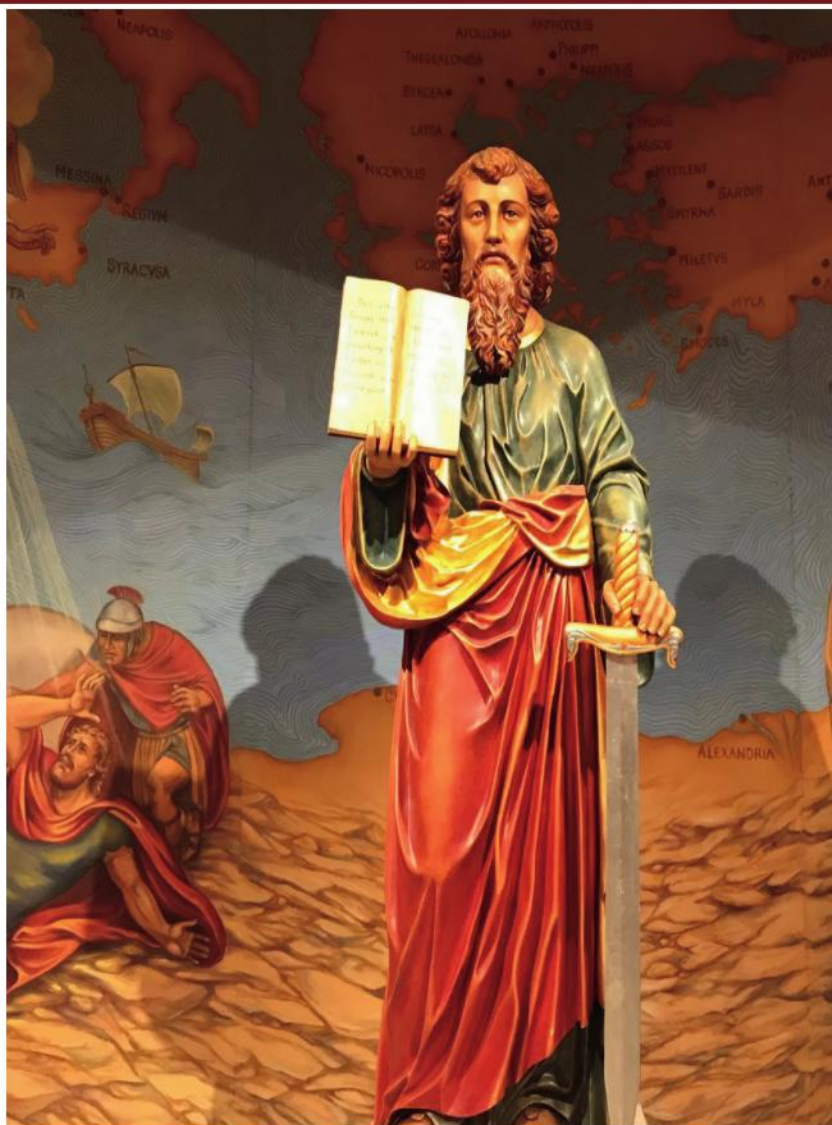

San Ignacio de Antioquía Día de la Fiesta - 17 de octubre

Ignacio se convirtió al cristianismo. Cuando fue nombrado segundo obispo de Antioquía, Siria, Ignacio se convirtió en sucesor de San Pedro. En el año 107, el emperador Trajano intentó obligar a los cristianos a renunciar a su religión. Ignacio permitió que los soldados lo ataran a un carro destartado y lo llevaran a Roma para ser martirizado. A medida que su carro entraba en las ciudades, los obispos y cristianos locales acudían a recibirlo y animarlo. Su amigo San Policarpo, obispo de Esmirna, lo recibió con gran honor, porque vio la santidad de Ignacio.

Durante el viaje, Ignacio escribió siete cartas a las iglesias que dejaba atrás. Las cartas dan una idea del crecimiento de la teología. Ignacio alabó el amor y el apoyo que recibió en su camino a Roma. Insistió en que el pueblo obedeciera a su obispo y actuara solo con su aprobación. «Dondequiera que esté el obispo, allí esté el pueblo, porque allí está la Iglesia católica» (Carta a la Iglesia de Esmirna 8,1-2). Ignacio escribió que Cristo estaba presente en la Iglesia, en cada miembro y en el Santísimo Sacramento. De sí mismo dijo: «Soy el trigo de Cristo, que sea molido por los dientes de las bestias para convertirme en el pan inmaculado de Cristo». Pidió a su pueblo que se reuniera en torno a la Eucaristía y que cuidara de «las viudas, los huérfanos, los oprimidos, así como de los presos, los hambrientos y los sedientos» (Carta a la Iglesia de Esmirna 6,2). Se autodenominaba «el portador de Dios». Ignacio fue devorado por las fieras en el anfiteatro romano.

Saint Ignatius of Antioch Feast day October 17th



Ignatius was a convert to Christianity. When he was named the second bishop of Antioch, Syria, Ignatius became a successor of Saint Peter. In 107, Emperor Trajan tried to force Christians to renounce their religion.

Ignatius allowed soldiers to bind him in a rickety cart and lead him to Rome for martyrdom. As his cart rolled into towns, local bishops and Christians came to meet and encourage him. His friend Saint Polycarp, the bishop of Smyrna, received him with great honor, because he saw Ignatius's holiness.

On the journey, Ignatius wrote seven letters to the churches he left behind. The letters give insight into the growth of theology. Ignatius praised the love and support he experienced on his way to Rome. He insisted that the people obey their bishop and act only with his approval. "Wherever the bishop is, there let the people be, for there is the Catholic Church." (Letter to the Church at Smyrna 8.1-2) Ignatius wrote that Christ was present in the Church, in each member, and in the Blessed Sacrament. Of himself, he said, "I am the wheat of Christ, may I be ground by the teeth of beasts to become the immaculate bread of Christ." He asked his people to gather around the Eucharist and to care for "the widow, the orphan, the oppressed, as well as those in prison, the hungry and the thirsty." (Letter to the Church at Smyrna 6.2) He called himself "the bearer of God." Ignatius was devoured by wild beasts in the Roman amphitheater.

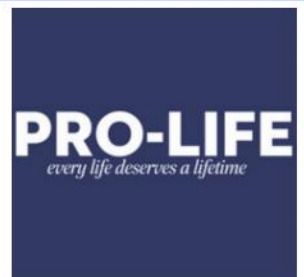

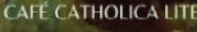
