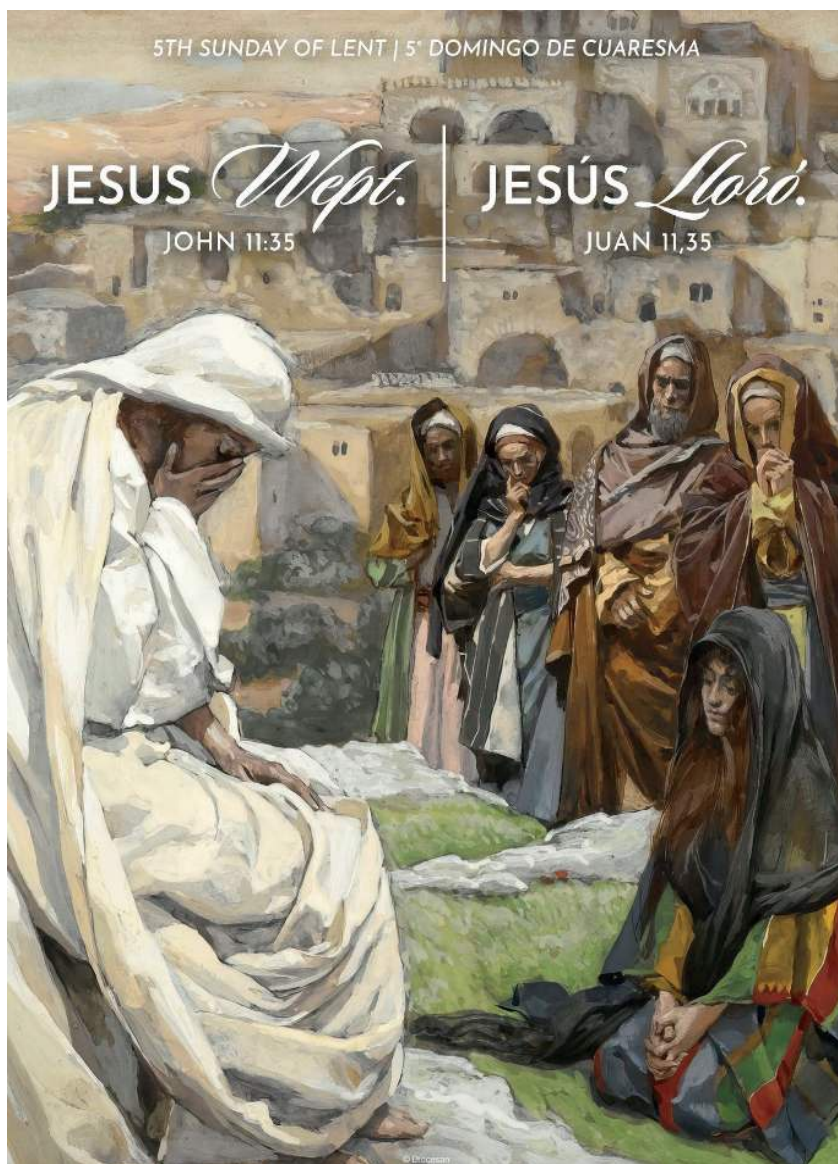

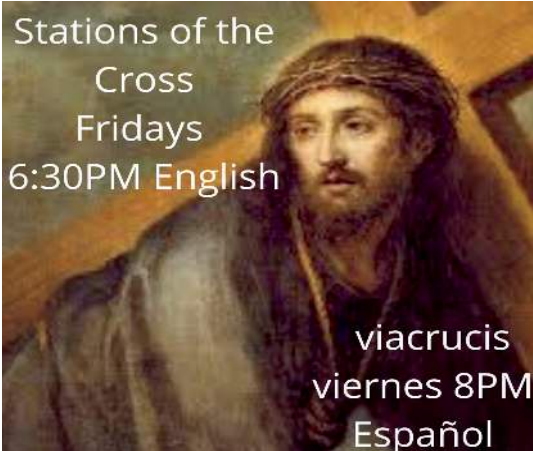

Background on 5th Sunday of Lent Gospel Reading

Our Gospel on this day, the fifth Sunday of Lent, is again taken from the Gospel according to John. Today's Gospel reading recounts another sign, or miracle, found in John's Gospel, the raising of Lazarus. As our catechumens move closer to the celebration of their Baptisms at the Triduum, today's reading invites us to reflect upon what it means to call Jesus the Resurrection and the life.

Set against the backdrop of Jesus' impending death, many elements of the raising of Lazarus foreshadow the good news of Jesus' own Resurrection. Jesus, facing the conflict with the Jewish authorities, acts in complete obedience to God. In raising Lazarus, Jesus shows his power over death so that when Jesus dies, those who believe in him might remember that and take hope. Just as Jesus calls for the stone to be rolled away from Lazarus's tomb, so too will the disciples find the stone rolled away from Jesus' tomb.

With our catechumens preparing for their Baptism at Easter, the Gospel today calls us to reflect on Baptism as a dying and rising with Jesus. In Baptism we die to sin's power over us, rising as children of God. In Baptism we join ourselves with Christ, who conquered death once and for all so that we who believe in him may have eternal life. With Martha and Mary, we are called to profess our belief that Jesus is indeed the Resurrection and the life.

Contexto del Evangelio del 5to. Domingo

Nuestro Evangelio en este día, el quinto domingo de Cuaresma, está tomado nuevamente del Evangelio según San Juan. La lectura de hoy relata otro signo o milagro que se encuentra en el Evangelio de Juan: la resurrección de Lázaro. A medida que nuestros catecúmenos se acercan a la celebración de sus Bautismos durante el Triduo, la lectura de hoy nos invita a reflexionar sobre lo que significa llamar a Jesús la Resurrección y la Vida.

Situado en el contexto de la muerte inminente de Jesús, muchos elementos de la resurrección de Lázaro anticipan la buena noticia de la propia Resurrección de Jesús. Jesús, enfrentando el conflicto con las autoridades judías, actúa en plena obediencia a Dios. Al resucitar a Lázaro, Jesús muestra su poder sobre la muerte para que, cuando él mismo muera, quienes creen en él recuerden esto y encuentren esperanza. Así como Jesús pide que se quite la piedra del sepulcro de Lázaro, también los discípulos encontrarán la piedra removida del sepulcro de Jesús.

Con nuestros catecúmenos preparándose para su Bautismo en Pascua, el Evangelio de hoy nos llama a reflexionar sobre el Bautismo como morir y resucitar con Jesús. En el Bautismo morimos al poder del pecado sobre nosotros y resucitamos como hijos de Dios. En el Bautismo nos unimos a Cristo, quien venció la muerte de una vez para siempre, para que quienes creen en él tengan vida eterna. Con Marta y María, también nosotros estamos llamados a profesar nuestra fe en que Jesús es verdaderamente la Resurrección y la Vida.

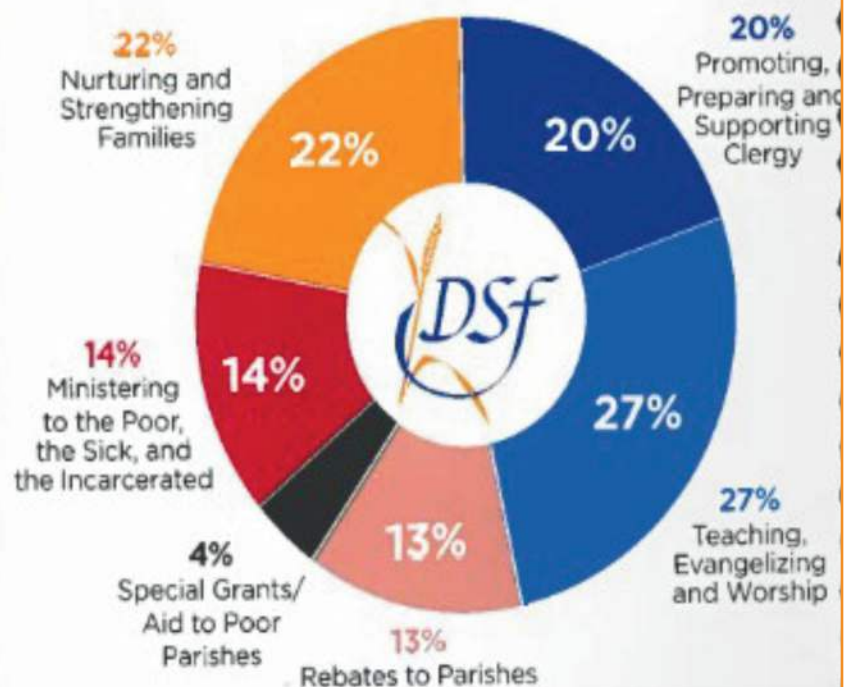
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The Principles of Catholic Social Justice

- Dignity of the Human Person:** Human life is sacred; each person is made in the image of God. This is the foundation of all Catholic Social Justice teaching.
- The Common Good and Community:** To "love your neighbor" has individual and broad social commitments. Everyone has a responsibility to contribute to the common good.
- Preferential Option for the Poor and Vulnerable:** The moral test of a society is how it treats its most vulnerable members. The poor have the most urgent moral claim on the conscience of a nation.
- Rights and Responsibilities:** Every person has a fundamental right to life and a right to the things required for human decency, including food, shelter, clothing, employment, health care, and education. Corresponding to these rights are duties and responsibilities. We are called to work globally for justice.
- Subsidiarity and the Role of Government:** The principle of subsidiarity holds that the functions of government should be performed by and at the level as close as possible to and by the people most affected. Only when needs cannot be met adequately is a higher level of government required to provide help for the common good. Authentic development must be full, human development as a requirement for human dignity.
- Economic Justice:** The economy must serve people, not the other way around. Workers have a right to productive work, to decent and fair wages, to safe working conditions, and a right to organize. Rights to economic initiatives and private property have limits. Catholic teaching opposes amassing excessive wealth when others lack the basic necessities of life.
- Stewardship of God's Creation:** How we treat the environment is a sign of our respect for our Creator. The goods of the earth are gifts from God and are intended by God for the benefit of everyone. We have a responsibility to care for these goods as stewards, not as consumers.
- Promotion of Peace and Disarmament:** Peace is the fruit of justice and is dependent upon right order among human beings. Peace is a positive, action-oriented concept. "Peace is not just the absence of war. It involves mutual respect and confidence between peoples and nations. It involves collaboration and binding agreements." (Pope John Paul II)

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
